SECTION IX. NARRATIVE

At 1801 on 25 August 2018, an unknown caller contacted PFC (b) (6) in the guard shack at NRC Solomons and reported that multiple boats were on fire at the marina on board NRC Solomons. PFC (b) (6) alerted NDW Emergency Communications and responded to the scene. Sergeant (b) (6) and PFC (b) (6) also responded to the scene.

PFC (b) (6) arrived on scene at 1803 to find 2 jet skis and 2 boats on fire in the parking lot on Ramp Road.

At 1806, Solomons and Saint Leonard Volunteer Fire Departments responded to the scene and extinguished the fires. Solomons Ambulance 38 and Calvert Advanced Life Support arrived on scene and began treating the victim V/(b) (6) for burns to his face, neck, and arms. Due to the nature of his injuries, the decision was made to send V/(b) (6) to a burn center via helicopter. The fires were under control at approximately 1817.

PFC (b) (6) arrived on scene at 1809. He observed 2 trailered jet skis and a trailered 12 foot boat that were completely destroyed by fire. 2 other trailered boats and an empty boat trailer sustained functional damage. PFC (b) (6) began identifying the owners of all affected watercraft and trailers and began notifying the owners with assistance from MWR staff.

PFC (b) (6) observed the following damage:

2 Multi Colored 1997 Bombardier GT 1 jet skis, owned by V/(b) (6) were completely destroyed by fire. Both jet skis were on the same trailer.

An 18 foot fiberglass Seaswirl Striper boat, owned by V/(b) (6) was burned on the rear of the port side. The burn was approximately 4 feet in length and extended from the bottom of the hull to the top of the gunwale. The rubber seal between the hull and gunwale was burned off. The fender on the port side of the trailer, a 1999 EZ Loader boat trailer bearing Maryland registration (b) (6) was melted onto the fire. This boat was positioned immediately to the left of the 2 jet skis.

A 15 foot fiberglass Wahoo boat, owned by V/(b) (6) was completely destroyed by fire and the hull on the starboard side was compromised. This boat was positioned immediately to the right of the 2 jet skis.

An 18 foot Karavan boat trailer bearing Maryland temporary registration (b) (6) owned by V/(b) (6) had a melted plastic upright guide on the port side. This trailer was positioned immediately to the right of the 15 foot Wahoo boat.

A 22 foot fiberglass Bayliner Ciera Express boat, owned by V/(b) (6) had a hole burned into the boat cover approximately 8 inches in diameter. The rubber seal between the hull and gunwale was also melted in this area. This boat was positioned immediately to the right of the Karavan trailer.

At 1819 Sergeant (b) (6) arrived on scene and met with witness W/(b) (6). W/(b) (6) is an NDW firefighter and paramedic assigned to NAS Patuxent River and she resides on NRC Solomons. W/(b) (6) reported that V/(b) (6) arrived at her camp site with burns to his torso and face asking for medical attention. W/(b) (6) stated V/(b) (6) told her he was performing maintenance on one of his jet skis when a small explosion occurred. He immediately drove from the scene to her camp site. W/(b) (6) began treating his injuries and was alerted to the fire in the marina by her son. W/(b) (6) then transported V/(b) (6) back to the marina to get him to the responding ambulance that had arrived on scene. W/(b) (6) further stated that V/(b) (6) was unaware of the fire that ensued after he departed the marina.

NDW Fire Chief 13A (b) (6) arrived on scene at 1826 to assist in the fire investigation and to assess any hazmat danger to the environment.

NAS Patuxent River CDO (b) (6) arrived on scene at 1835

At 1843, Maryland State Police Helicopter "Trooper 6" arrived on scene and departed with V/(b) (6) at 1849 to Johns Hopkins Bay View Hospital in Baltimore.

At 1944, NAS Patuxent River Port Operations Supervisor, (b) (6) arrived on scene to assess any environmental hazard to the waterway. His investigation revealed no significant hazards.

On 26 August 2018, V/(b) (6) was able to make a written voluntary statement to PFC (b) (6) that corroborates W/(b) (6) statement. He also stated he was trying to figure out why one of his jet skis would not start. He removed a spark plug and cranked the engine to see if the spark plug was working. At that time, the fuel and air mixture exited the cylinder through the spark plug hole and ignited, sending a ball of fire into his face causing his injuries and subsequently starting the fire. He sustained 1st degree burns to his arms, neck and face. He is expected to make a full recovery with no disabilities.

This case is submitted in a closed status and is subjected to be reopened pending any new investigative information. ///End of Report///

X 25 AUG 18 @ 1730 ^{approx} I was going to ride my jet ski, went to hook up trailer and start the ski. I changed the battery with a fully charged one because it was having a hard time starting. After I put the battery on it still wouldn't turn over. So I pulled a plug out to see if it would turn over. The motor turned over and fuel was shot out of the cylinder and ignited. I jumped/fell back and realized I had been burnt on my face and arms. I jumped back in the truck and came back home where my neighbor could help me she is an EMT. When I left the jet ski I didn't know it was far was going to be on fire. Shortly after I made it back to my neighbor, she informed me that there was smoke and the jet ski was on fire. My neighbor and I jumped in a vehicle and went back over there, my wife called 911 when we left.
