“Wings Over the Pacific” Air Show volunteers needed

PEARL HARBOR-HICKAM – Volunteer opportunities are available for the 2014 “Wings Over the Pacific” Air Show scheduled for Sept. 27 and 28 from 10 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. at Joint Base Pearl Harbor-Hickam. Volunteering provides an opportunity to help the community, gain new skills and see the U. S. Navy’s world-famous flight demonstration squadron, Blue Angels.

Volunteer opportunities are open to military and civilians; volunteers must be at least 16 years old. Volunteer tasks include the following:

Set-Up/Tear Down – Assist in setting up tents, booths, cattle guards, and other equipment; availability beginning Wednesday, Sept. 24.

Event Operations – Assist in trash disposal, recycling, water booths, and other operations as necessary; requires flexible hours and availability.

Chalet Ushers – Welcome patrons to the event, verify tickets and provide wrist bands for the seating in VIP Flight Line Club and Premium Box Seats.

Parking – Direct patrons to designated parking areas.

The Wings Over the Pacific air show will also feature aerial demonstrations by the U. S. Navy’s parachute team, commonly known as the “Leap Frogs,” and the F-22 Raptor Demo Team. These acts and more are scheduled to perform both days subject to weather conditions. The show will also offer static displays of vintage and modern aircraft, food and merchandise booths, and “Xtreme Fun Zone” for the kids, featuring rides, games and more. Optional premium seating tickets are available for purchase.

The air show is open to the public, and general admission and parking are free. Gates open at 10 a.m., and patrons are encouraged to carpool.
