About the Job	<p>The incumbent interprets all applicable regulations, policies, fire and life safety codes as may be necessary for enforcement. Complies and tracks activity statistics for regular and special task reports. Conducts multi-level reviews of plans and specifications for building construction and modifications. Monitors new and existing structures and properties for construction, occupancy, fire protection and exposures. The incumbent prepares correspondence and inspection reports. Maintains records, performs research, interprets codes, implements policy, testifies at legal proceedings and creates forms and job aids. The incumbent also interprets codes, suggests modifications and improvements to policies on an ongoing basis and maintains timely, complete and accurate records on all discrepancies and related communications. Issues fire permits, conducts fire inspections, investigates and resolves potential violations of laws, ordinances, codes and regulations including, but not limited to building and fire codes and nuisance abatement regulations and provides information and general assistance to commands, businesses, the public, contractors and vendors. Develops public fire and life safety education programs, including program budgets. Selects instructional materials and related resources which are appropriate to the audience and program objectives. Ensures that the information provided is accurate, relevant to the issue and comprehensible to the audience. Presents public fire protection and life safety education programs to motivate the general public and tenant commands to maintain a proactive stance toward fire risks based on proper fire-safe behavior. Documents all elements of the programs. Assists in training fire suppression personnel to conduct fire and life safety inspections. Works productively with others with minimal supervision. Prioritizes work to meet goals and objectives within acceptable time frames.</p>
