DESCRIPTION:	(Sexual Assault Prevention & Response - Civilians) SAPR-C One Team, One Fight is a mandatory training for all DON civilians and military personnel who supervise civilians. This training meets Congressional, Department of Defense, and DON requirements for civilians and is optional for contractors and MLC's. The initial training taken by new hires or military personnel who supervise civilians that have not had SAPR-C previously, MUST be received in person. Each remaining year the required refresher training may be conducted via Computer Based Training (CBT) using the Total Workforce Management System (TWMS) as discussed in PACADMIN 010/14. The Secretary of the Navy (SECNAV) is committed to combating sexual assault through programs that focus on reducing the incidence of sexual assaults and providing effective and compassionate support for victims of sexual assault.
