

NEW SANNO HOTEL BY TRAIN

DOD travelers planning to stay in Tokyo may want to use the New Sanno Hotel. It is located in one of the most sophisticated, modern cities in the world. From YOKOSUKA:

1. At **YOKOSUKA CHUO (横須賀中央) Station**, buy a ¥770 transfer ticket to **EBISU (恵比寿) Station** via the **JR YAMANOTE (JR 山手線) Line**.
****Note**** To buy a transfer ticket, touch the following buttons on the screen:
<<<English → Ticket → Connecting Ticket tab → Change at Shinagawa JR Line → Ticket fare amount>>>
2. Go to **Track #2** and take a train with either a GREEN or RED Kanji sign bound for Yokohama/ Shinagawa direction.
****Note**** **If possible, get on one of the last two cars of the train. This will make it easier and faster to find the entrance to the JR Lines at Shinagawa Station .**
3. Get off at **SHINAGAWA Station**. Take the stairs up and follow the elevated walkway near the end of the platform. Go through the wicket machines to enter the JR Line area. **Do not forget to retrieve your ticket.** Go to **Track #2** of the **JR YAMANOTE Line** bound for SHIBUYA and SHINJUKU direction.
EBISU Station is the 4th stop from SHINAGAWA Station.
4. Get off at **EBISU Station** and use the **West Exit (西口)** to transfer to **HIBIYA Subway Line (gray circle)** located outside of the station. After going through the wicket machines, turn left and walk all the way to the end of the hallway. Then, take the escalator going down toward the street level and the entrance to the HIBIYA Subway Line.
5. Buy a ¥160 subway ticket, go to **Track #2**, and take a train bound for GINZA and UENO direction. Make sure to ride on the last two cars of the train for quick and easy access to **Exit #1 at HIROO Station**.
6. Get off at **HIROO (広尾) Station** and leave through **Exit #1**. At street level, turn left, and use the map on the opposite page as a guide for walking directions toward the New Sanno Hotel.

Alternative Train Route

YOKOSUKA CHUO Station → KEIKYU Line → Get off at YOKOHAMA Station → Follow signs for TOKYU-TOYOKO Line → TOKYU-TOYOKO Line → Get off at NAKA-MEGURO Station → Go to Track #3 → Transfer to HIBIYA Subway Line → Get off at HIROO Station → Exit #1 → Walk to New Sanno Hotel.


From IKEGO:

1. At **JIMMUJI (神武寺) Station**, buy a ¥700 transfer ticket to **EBISU (恵比寿) Station** via the **JR YAMANOTE (JR 山手線) Line**. See note in **Step #1** in the directions of "From Yokosuka."
2. Go to **Track #2** and take a train to **KANAZAWA HAKKEI Station**.
3. Get off at **KANAZAWA HAKKEI Station**, go to **Track #3**, and transfer to a **KEIKYU MAIN LINE** train with either a RED or GREEN kanji sign bound for YOKOHAMA and SHINAGAWA direction.
****Note** If possible, get on one of the last two cars of the train. This will make it easier and faster to find the entrance to the JR Lines at Shinagawa Station.**
4. Continue with **Step #3** in the directions "**From Yokosuka**" or the alternative bus route below.

ALTERNATIVE ROUTE by BUS:

****Note** Instead of riding the last two cars of a KEIKYU Line train, ride the first two cars for easy and fast access to the stairs at the front of the tracks at SHINAGAWA Station.**

1. At SHINAGAWA Station, go down the stairs near the front of the tracks. As you exit the station, look for a pedestrian overpass directly in front of the station.
2. Cross the overpass and go to the bus stops in front of **Shinagawa GOOS**.
3. Go to **Bus stop #7** and take green & Orange color TOEI Bus (都営バス), **Bus #97 (品 97) for SHINJYUKU station West Exit (新宿駅西口)**. The bus runs approximately every 20 minutes. The ride will cost ¥200 (exact change needed) and takes about 10 - 15 minutes.
4. Get off at the **TENGENJI-BASHI (天現寺橋) bus stop**. Look back in the direction from which the bus came and you will see the New Sanno Hotel across the street.
****Note** For your safety, use the pedestrian overpass at the TENGENJI CROSSING.**
