

# SEA PARADISE by TRAIN or CAR

Hakkeijima, Kanazawa-ku, Yokohama-shi

Sea Paradise is a seaside amusement park worth a full day's outing. The Aqua Museum is well-known for its enormous fish tank containing 70,000 species of fish and the first aqua escalator and in Japan. The escalator leads onto a tunnel-viewing area which allows visitors to walk through an "underwater world" and provides a unique perspective of the sea creatures. The park also offers animal shows for entertainment, a marina for a relaxing and leisurely stroll, a market for souvenir shopping, and several restaurants from casual to fine dining. The park is proud of its amusement rides such as the Surf Coaster, which swings out over the sea, the Blue Fall, which is an exhilarating vertical fall ride, and their world famous Merry-Go-Round glittering with thousands of lights.


## BY TRAIN

### From YOKOSUKA:

1. At **YOKOSUKA CHUO** (横須賀中央) station, buy a **¥200** ticket to **KANAZAWA-HAKKEI** (金沢八景) station.
2. Go to **Track #2**, take any train with a GREEN, RED or BLACK Kanji sign bound for Yokohama/ Shinagawa.
3. Get off at **KANAZAWA-HAKKEI** station which is the 1st stop from Yokosuka Chuo by GREEN, the 3rd stop by RED and 6th stop by BLACK Kanji trains.
4. After exiting the station, go straight toward the main road (Rt. 16). Turn left and go take the pedestrian overpass to take the **SEASIDE Line** (シーサイドライン).
5. Buy a **¥260** ticket to **HAKKEIJIMA** (八景島) Station (4th stop from KANAZAWA HAKKEI).
6. Turn left once you exit HAKKEIJIMA Station and walk for about 3-5 minutes toward the park entrance.

### From IKEGO:

1. At **JINMUJI** (神武寺) station, buy a **¥160** ticket to **KANAZAWA-HAKKEI** (金沢八景) station.
2. **Continue with Step #3 above.**



**IMPORTANT NOTICE:** Many onsen bath houses, public pools, and even amusement parks prohibit the display of visible tattoos, especially in the Tokyo greater metropolitan area. If you have visible tattoos (permanent or temporary), you should consider contacting the park establishment before making a trip. Some parks allow admission if tattoos can be completely covered.

## BY CAR via YOKO-YOKO Toll Road

### From YOKOSUKA:

1. Turn right onto Rt. 16 as you exit the main gate. After driving past Shoppers Plaza, move into the rightmost lane.
2. Drive up the ramp onto **HONCHO-YAMANAKA Toll Road** and pay ¥210. Keep left at the 1<sup>st</sup> Y-split and follow the signs for **YOKOHAMA-YOKOSUKA Toll Road**.
3. At the next tollgate, take a ticket, keep right at the 2nd Y-split, and follow the signs for **YOKOHAMA**.
4. After Exit #5 **ASAHINA**, stay in the left lane.
5. Follow the signs for **NAMIKI/HANEDA AIRPORT/SHUTO EXPRESSWAY B**.
6. Pay ¥510 (¥470 from ZUSHI ) at **KAMARIYA** tollgate. Follow signs for **SHUTO EXPWY B**.
7. Exit off at **NAMIKI**. **Keep left at the Y-split**, drive straight, and turn right onto **Rt. 357** at the **3rd stoplight SACHIURA 2 intersection**.
8. Drive straight on **Rt. 357** all the way to **KANAZAWA SHIBACHO intersection (4th stoplight from SACHIURA 2-CHOME intersection)**. The Hakkeijima parking garage is located at this intersection.


### From IKEGO:

1. After exiting through the Ikego main gate, go straight then turn left onto Rt. 24 at the 7-Eleven store T-junction.
2. At the 6th stoplight, turn right and drive up the ramp onto **YOKOHAMA-YOKOSUKA Toll Road**.
3. Take a ticket at the toll gate, keep left at the Y-splits, and follow the signs toward **YOKOHAMA**.
4. **Continue with Step #4 above.**

## BY CAR via Rt. 16

### From YOKOSUKA:

1. Turn right onto Rt. 16 as you exit the main gate. Stay on Rt. 16 for about 7~8 km.
2. After driving past **Rt. 16/ Rt. 23 intersection** (see Picture 1 below), stay in the right lane.
3. Turn right at the **SETO JINJA-MAE intersection** (3rd stoplight from the intersection) toward **UMINO-KOEN (海の公園)**. (see Picture 2 below).
4. Go straight, and after driving past a **Bamiyan Restaurant** (see Picture 3 below), turn left at the **KIHAN-BASHI intersection** (1st stoplight).
5. Stay on this road which is parallel to the elevated SEASIDE Line and Hakkeijima Sea Paradise to your right.
6. Continue straight and pay attention to the blue road signs for Rt. 357. **Turn left onto Rt. 357 at the KANAZAWA SHIBACHO intersection and go straight. Pay attention to the blue road sign for SACHIURA.**
7. Turn right at the **SACHIURA 2-chome intersection**. You will then see Costco at the upper left corner of the 2nd intersection.

### From IKEGO:

1. After exiting through the Ikego gate, turn left onto **Rt. 205/ASAHINA** at the first stoplight.
2. Drive straight at **MUTSUURA Bypass S** intersection, and follow the street.
3. After drive underneath YOKO-YOKO Toll Road, turn left at the first stoplight **SANSHIN JYUTAKU Ent.**
4. Drive the hill all the way up. Keep right at the Y-split and next stoplight **SANSHIN CENTER**.
5. Turn right at the T-intersection **SANSHIN JYUTAKU Ent. N**, onto Rt. 23 toward **YOKOSUKA/ISOGO**.
6. Keep driving on the Rt. 23 and stay in the left lane to make a **left turn** onto **Rt. 16** at the T-junction ahead.
7. Turn left onto Rt. 16 towards **ISOGO/ HAKKEIJIMA** then **stay in the right lane**.
8. **Continue with Step #3 above in the directions "BY CAR via Rt. 16 From YOKOSUKA."**
