The show begins at 10:00 and you may begin arriving at 9:30 am.

This year we are excited to announce that all of the air show performers will be encouraged to stop by the chalet before or after their performance to talk, sign autographs or to take pictures. The performers include the GEICO Skytypers, Kent Pietsch, Greg Shelton, the Shockwave Jet Truck, Bob Carlton, Bill Leff and our local pilots based at NAS Oceana. While we cannot promise a visit by the Blue Angels, we will certainly request it.

The Noblemen will be supplying pizza and water for lunch via MWR. This will be supplied at no cost to families. Also, the air show will be held rain or shine. We do not expect traffic to be a problem since this show is not open to the public.


When registering please provide the following information:

1. Sponsor name/rank/rate/command
2. Name of the EFM family member
3. Number of people in immediate family that will be attending (Immediate family only please)
4. Email address and telephone number
5. FFSC preference for pass pick-up

## **Base Access / Parking:**

Guests will need an EFMP/Noblemen Parking Pass to access the designated parking lot for the show, which we will supply with your registration. Don't forget to bring your military ID as well. Please enter the base through the Main Gate off of Oceana Blvd. If you need assistance or do not have your EFMP/Noblemen Parking Pass, there will be an EFMP/Noblemen check-in tent at the entrance to Main Gate Park off of Tomcat Blvd.

Parking for EFMP/Noblemen families will be located in a designated handicapped parking area located in a lot behind Hangar 200 (see map below; base security will direct you). Once you have parked in the lot, The Noblemen will be available to direct you to the VIP chalet and assist anyone who might need it.



**Other Info:**

- We suggest bringing ear **plugs or headphones** especially if you child has autism to help block the sound since we will be located on the flight line.
- Wheelchairs, walkers, strollers, cell phones, handheld scanners, radios, small fanny packs, purses, cameras and camcorders WILL be allowed.
- Accessible toilets will be available close to the chalet.
- Ice chests, coolers, large bags, weapons, knives, alcoholic beverages, pets and glass containers are NOT allowed on base.
