**Exercise Solid Curtain-Citadel Shield 2016** – Commander, U.S. Fleet Forces (USFF) and Commander, Naval Installations Command (CNIC) will conduct Exercise Solid Curtain-Citadel Shield 2015 on board NCBC Gulfport and all other Navy installations located in the continental United States, Feb. 1 – 12. This annual anti-terrorism force protection exercise is designed to train Navy security forces to respond to threats to installations and units. Although exercise coordinators have taken measures to minimize disruptions to normal base operations, there may be times when the exercise causes increased traffic around the base or delays in base access. People on board NCBC can expect the installation to be locked down Feb. 1 from 8 to 9 a.m., during an active shooter/shelter in place drill. **Base personnel should register for the AtHoc wide-area alert network to stay up to date on force protection conditions and other emergency, environmental, or exercise-related impacts on the area.**

**Register to Vote** - If you would like to register to vote, visit [FVAP.gov](http://FVAP.gov) now to complete a registration application and request your absentee ballots for the presidential preference primaries (P) and State primaries (S). It only takes a few quick steps to make sure your vote is counted no matter where you are in the world. To register and request your ballots, complete the Federal Post Card Application (FPCA) using the FPCA online assistant ([fvap.gov/military-voter/registration-ballots](http://fvap.gov/military-voter/registration-ballots)), or fill out the PDF ([fvap.gov/uploads/FVAP/Forms/fpca2013.pdf](http://fvap.gov/uploads/FVAP/Forms/fpca2013.pdf)), or pick up a hardcopy version from your Voting Assistance Officer or nearest U.S. Embassy or Consular Office. **The Voting Officer for NCBC Gulfport is Lt.
