Subj: MOTORCYCLE SAFETY PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

Ref: (1) OPNAVINST 5100.12J

1. Per references (a) and (b) all persons, whether military, civilian, retiree or dependent, are required to wear Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) while operating motorcycles onboard Naval Air Station (NAS) Pensacola. Requirements for riders and passengers are:

a. Motorcycle Endorsement on a state-issued Driver License or foreign equivalent. Three-wheeled vehicle operators may be exempt from the endorsement, depending on state of issue. (All other requirements below still apply to three-wheeled vehicles).

b. Helmets that meet minimum Department of Transportation (DOT) standards. Snell Memorial Foundation, British and European standards exceed DOT requirements and are acceptable as well.

c. Gloves, Full-fingered, (i.e. no 'fingerless' gloves)

d. Footwear, over-the-ankle such as boots.

e. Long pants, long sleeves, motorcycle jacket is preferred.

f. Eye protection (helmet visor is acceptable)

g. Retro-reflective material is required at night and times of poor visibility.
