

JOGASHIMA ISLAND by TRAIN or CAR

JOGASHIMA ISLAND is a tiny island off the tip of the Miura Peninsula. A toll bridge runs from the mainland to the island. A small fishing village and sandy beaches are on the western end while the beautiful Jogashima Park is on the eastern end. Other points of interest are the Jogashima Lighthouse from which you can see Izu Peninsula, Ooshima Island and Bosu Peninsula in Chiba Prefecture and the nearby Misaki Fish Market. The market is open between 0800-2200. Keep in mind, though, that the market is not open daily and have no set schedule - but you may get lucky!.

BY TRAIN

From YOKOSUKA:

1. At **YOKOSUKA CHUO (横須賀中央) Station**, buy a ¥270 train ticket to **MISAKIGUCHI (三崎口) Station**.
2. Go to **Platform #1** and take a train with either a GREEN or RED kanji sign bound for **MISAKIGUCHI (三崎口)**, which is the last station of the Keikyu Line.
3. Get off at MISAKIGUCHI Station, then **take a Keikyu Bus #9 at Bus stop #2 bound for JOGASHIMA (城ヶ島)**. The ride takes about 30 minutes. Get off at the final stop.

From IKEGO:

1. At **JIMMUJI (神武寺) Station**, buy a ¥350 train ticket to **MISAKIGUCHI (三崎口) Station**.
2. Go to **Platform #2**, take a train to **KANAZAWA HAKKEI 金沢八景 Station**, then transfer to a **KEIKYU MAIN LINE** train with either a RED or GREEN kanji sign bound for **MISAKIGUCHI (三崎口)**.
3. **Continue with Step #3 above.**

BY CAR

A. From IKEGO by Yoko-Yoko Toll Road:

1. Exit Ikego main gate, drive straight, and turn left onto Rt. 24 at the 7-eleven corner.
2. Take the ramp on the right at the **Zushi I.C. to enter onto Yokohama-Yokosuka Toll Road** toward **MIURA (三浦)**. Follow the signs for the **Yokohama-Yokosuka Toll Road** heading toward **MIURA (三浦)**.
3. Exit at **KINUGASA I.C.**, pay a ¥350 toll fee, keep left, and follow the signs going to **MIURA JYUKAN TOLL ROAD (三浦縦貫道路)**. Drive all the way to the end of the toll road and pay a ¥300 toll fee.
4. Turn left onto **Rt. 134/MISAKI and HAYAMA**. You will pass by a modern-looking sports arena and Misakiguchi train station on your left. After passing Misakiguchi station, you will come to the **Hikibashi (引橋) Y-Junction**.
5. **Make a slight right turn onto Rt. 26/Misaki and Jogashima at this junction.** Rt. 134 continues on to the left.
6. Stay on **Rt. 26/Jogashima and Tsurugizaki**. After driving past a 7-Eleven store and Big Boy restaurant on your right, get ready to make a **left turn** at the **Jogashima-iriguchi (城ヶ島入り口) intersection**. You will see an Eneos gas station on the left corner, then a Kygnus gas station also to your left.
7. The next blue road sign is 1km ahead and it will lead you to the toll bridge to the island. Pay a toll fee of ¥150 for cars or ¥300 for vans. The trip takes about 45-50 minutes when traffic flow is light.

B. From IKEGO By Zuyo-Shindo Toll Road:

1. From the main gate, go straight to the 7-Eleven intersection and **turn left** onto **Route 24** toward the entrance ramp onto **Zuyo-Shindo Toll Rd. following the signs for KAMAKURA and HAYAMA**.
2. Drive through a long tunnel, and finally, pay the ¥100 toll fee. After the tollgate, Zuyo Toll Rd. ends and **Rt. 311, heading toward Kamakura and Zushi, begins**.
3. Stay on Rt. 311 until you reach the **Nagae (長柄) intersection**. **Rt. 311 merges with Rt. 134 at this intersection**.
4. **Continue with Step #4 in the directions of "From Yokosuka By Yoko-Yoko Toll Rd."**

BY CAR

A. From YOKOSUKA by Yoko-Yoko Toll Road:

1. Exit Yokosuka main gate and turn right onto **Rt. 16**. After passing Daiei, move into the right lane.
2. Take the ramp on the right onto **Honcho-Yamanaka Toll Road (本町山中有料道路)** and pay ¥200 toll fee. Keep left at the 1st fork and follow signs for the **Yokohama-Yokosuka Toll Road toward MIURA (三浦)**.
3. Exit at **KINUGASA**, pay a ¥250 toll fee, keep left, and follow the signs going to **MIURA JYUKAN TOLL ROAD (三浦縦貫道路)**. Drive all the way to the end of the toll road and pay a ¥300 toll fee.
4. Turn left onto **Rt. 134/Misaki and Hayama** and stay on this road. You will pass by a modern-looking sports arena and Misakiguchi train station on your left. After passing Misakiguchi station, you will come to the **Hikibashi (引橋) Y-Junction**.
5. **Make a slight right turn onto Rt. 26/Misaki and Jogashima at this junction.** Rt. 134 continues on to the left.
6. Stay on **Rt. 26/Jogashima and Tsurugizaki**. After you have passed a 7-Eleven store and Big Boy restaurant on your right, get ready to make a **left turn** at the **Jogashima-iriguchi (城ヶ島入り口) intersection**. You will see an Eneos gas station on the left corner.
7. The next blue road sign is 1km ahead and it will lead you to the toll bridge to the island. Pay a toll fee of ¥150 for cars or ¥300 for vans. The trip takes about 45-50 minutes when traffic flow is light.

B. From YOKOSUKA By Route 16:

1. Turn left at the main gate onto **Rt. 16 heading toward Misaki**. Follow the blue road signs for Rt. 16 and 134.
2. At the Otsu intersection (KFC and Shell gas station corner), **turn right to Rt. 134/Kurihama**.
3. Continue on **Rt.134/Kurihama and Ferry Port**. Stay in the left lane and drive straight to Rt. 134 past the junction where it branches off to the right to Rt. 27/Yoko-Yoko Toll Rd. and Kamakura.
4. After passing D2 store and ZAP Pachinko on your left and PS1 Pachinko on your right, get ready to make a right turn to **Rt. 134/Misaki and Jogashima**. After turning right, you will soon drive past an AEON department store on your left. Continue straight on Rt. 134/Jogashima.
5. After passing Nobi Yacht Club building on your left, Rt. 134 now becomes a coastal road passing SAHARA I.C. entrance to Yoko-Yoko Toll Road on your right and Lawson store on your left.
6. At the major junction ahead, follow the blue road signs toward **Rt. 134/Jogashima** taking the road where it goes between a McDonald's store on the left and an Idemitsu gas station on the right. Continue driving straight past a farm area and an NTT building on your left.
7. At the **Hikibashi (引橋) Y-Junction, Rt. 134 merges with Rt. 26. Turn left onto Rt. 26/Jogashima** (Rt. 134 continues on to the right). Once you see a 7-Eleven store then a Big Boy restaurant on your right, get ready to make a left turn at the next stoplight.
8. **Turn left at the Jogashima-iriguchi (城ヶ島入り口) intersection.** As you turn left, you should see an ENEOS gas station on the left corner, then a KYGNUS gas station also on your left.
9. From this point on, just follow the blue road signs to the entrance to the Jogashima toll bridge. The toll fee is ¥150 for cars and ¥300 for vans. Enjoy your day. It takes about 45-50 minutes when the traffic is average.
