

ROPPONGI

ROPPONGI, the most international district in Tokyo, is famous as one of the city's major nightlife districts claiming some of the best restaurants, bars and nightclubs in Tokyo. Life in Roppongi starts at the Roppongi crossing. The **Almond**, a pink coffee shop, is a famous landmark at the corner of Roppongi crossing. Another famous landmark is the **Square Building**, a potential entrant in the Guinness Book of World Records for housing seven dance floors in its ten-story building. **Hard Rock Cafe** is also located in Roppongi and is open Mondays to Thursdays from 1130 to 0200; Fridays to Saturdays from 1130 to 0400; and on Sundays from 1130 to 2030. Telephone number is 03-3408-7274. Just look for the building with **King Kong near the top** (see map for location). By day, Roppongi is relatively quiet. Two fairly recent buildings make it worth a daytime trip: the **Axis Building**, full of shops specializing in contemporary interior goods, and the **Wave**, the most advanced record store in the world.

From YOKOSUKA CHUO:

- **Route 1: One ticket for the entire trip. Total Fare is ¥900.**

1. At **YOKOSUKA CHUO (横須賀中央) Station**, buy a ¥900 transfer ticket to **ROPPONGI Station** via the **TOEI-OEDO Subway Line**.

****Note**** To buy a transfer ticket, touch the following buttons on the screen:

<<English →Ticket →Connecting Ticket tab →Change at Toei Line →Ticket fare amount>>

2. Go to **Platform #2** and take a train with either a GREEN or RED kanji sign bound for **SHINAGAWA (品川) Station**.

****Note****

~ Trains with a RED kanji sign run **from 5am to 8:30am and from 4:30pm to 6:30pm only**.

~ If you take a train with a RED kanji sign, stay on it until you reach **DAIMON Station (A09)**.

After Shinagawa Station, Keikyu Line merges with the TOEI ASAKUSA Subway Line.

~ If you take a train with a GREEN kanji sign, exit at **SHINAGAWA Station**, but stay on the same platform.

Take any of the next trains to **DAIMON Station (A09; 3rd stop from Shinagawa Station)**.

3. Get off at **DAIMON Station (A09)** and transfer to the **TOEI-OEDO Subway Line (purple circle)** bound for **SHINJUKU at Platform #4**.

4. Get off at Roppongi Station (E23; **3rd stop** from Daimon Station on the TOEI-OEDO Subway Line).

- **Route 2: Two tickets for the entire trip. Total Fare is ¥930.**

1. At **YOKOSUKA CHUO (横須賀中央) Station**, buy a ¥770 transfer ticket to **ROPPONGI Station** via the **JR YAMANOTE (JR 山手線) Line**.

****Note**** To buy a transfer ticket, touch the following buttons on the screen:

<<English →Ticket →Connecting Ticket tab →Change at Shinagawa JR Line →Ticket fare amount>>

2. Go to **Platform #2** and take a train with either a GREEN or RED kanji sign bound for **SHINAGAWA (品川) Station**.

****Note**** **If possible, get on one of the last two cars of the train. This will make it easier and faster to find the entrance to the JR Lines at Shinagawa (品川) Station.**

3. Get off at **SHINAGAWA 品川 Station**. Take the stairs up and follow the elevated walkway near the end of the platform. Go through the wicket machines to enter the JR Line area. **Do not forget to retrieve your ticket**. Go to **Platform #2** of the **JR YAMANOTE (JR 山手線) Line** bound for **SHIBUYA (渋谷) and SHINJUKU (新宿)**.

EBISU (恵比寿) Station (H02) is the **4th stop** from Shinagawa Station.

4. Get off at **EBISU (恵比寿) Station** and use the **West Exit (西口)** to transfer to the **HIBIYA Subway Line (gray circle)** located outside of the station. After going through the wicket machines, turn left and walk all the way to the end of the hallway. Then, take the escalator going down toward the street level and the entrance to the **HIBIYA Subway Line**.

5. Buy a ¥160 subway ticket, go to **Platform #2**, and take a train bound for **Ginza and Ueno**.

Get off at **Roppongi Station (H04; 2nd stop from Ebisu Station on the Hibiya Line)**.

6. Get off at Roppongi Station (H04; **2nd stop** from Hibiya Station).

From IKEGO:

1. At **JIMMUJI (神武寺) Station**, buy an ¥830 transfer ticket to **ROPPONGI** on the TOEI OEDO Line for **Route 1** or buy a ¥700 transfer ticket to **EBISU (恵比寿) Station** on the JR YAMANOTE Line via **SHINAGAWA Station** for **Route 2**.

See note in Step #1 above.

2. Go to **Platform #2** and take a train to **KANAZAWA HAKKEI (金沢八景) Station**. From there, transfer to a **KEIKYU MAIN LINE** train at **Platform #3** with either a GREEN or RED kanji sign bound for **SHINAGAWA (品川) Station**.

3. **Continue with notes in Step #2 above in the directions of "Route 1: ~" or in Step #3 in the directions of "Route 2: ~".**
