NAVAL STATION (NAVSTA) NEWPORT INSTRUCTION 5090.24A

Subj: AIR EMISSION SOURCE MANAGEMENT

Ref: (a) Clean Air Act, as amended.
(b) RI Air Pollution Control Regulations
(c) OPNAVINST 5090.1C, Chapter 7
(d) NAVSTA Newport Title V Air Permit, No. RI-25-07(R1)

1. Purpose. To outline procedures and responsibilities related to the management of air emission sources, per references (a), (b) and (c).

2. Cancellation. NAVSTANPTINST 5090.24.

3. Applicability. This instruction is applicable to all military and civilian personnel assigned to or working at NAVSTA Newport and its tenant commands. All contractors providing construction or other services at this facility are also subject to this instruction.

4. Policy. It is the policy of this command that all departments, tenant commands, personnel and contractors shall be familiar with the air emission sources within their cognizance listed in reference (d) and shall be familiar with all respective operating limits and record keeping and reporting requirements.

5. Action; New and Existing Air Emission Sources

a. All NAVSTA Newport departments and tenant commands shall submit in writing a description of the new air emission source that is being planned. The Air Program Manager will review these sources for possible permitting requirements and inclusion in reference (d).

b. Per reference (b), many new air emission sources may require operating permits. Installation of any new source prior to issuance of a required operating permit is a violation of state and Federal law. Therefore, all NAVSTA Newport departments and tenant commands shall notify the Air Program Manager, at 841-6378, prior to the design, procurement and/or installation or modification of any air emission source. Issuance of operating permits may take six to eighteen months. Notification to the Air Program Manager must be made as early as possible.
