Subj: DEPARTMENT OF THE NAVY REDUCTION IN FORCE (RIF)
REGULATIONS FOR U.S. CITIZEN EMPLOYEES

1. Purpose. To advise that references (a) and (b) are the federal government and Department of the Navy regulations which must be complied with in the event of a RIF of U.S. citizen employees and to establish local administrative responsibilities and competitive areas.

2. Cancellation. NAVSUPPACT NAPLES INST 12351.4.

3. Applicability. This instruction applies to all U.S. citizen appropriated fund civilian employees serviced by the Human Resources Office (HRO), U.S. Naval Support Activity, Naples, Italy.

4. Administrative Responsibilities. Commanding officers are responsible for determining the need and articulating a legitimate reason for reducing work forces resulting in a RIF and/or transfer of function impacting employees. Decisions of this kind, as a minimum, usually require second echelon command approval. Higher-level approval is necessary in instances affecting 50 or more civilians or when these actions would generate significant congressional interest, regardless of the numbers affected. The complexity and length of the RIF process requires much advance planning and coordination to achieve the desired and properly executed result. Therefore, top management will coordinate all phases of RIF actions and/or transfers of function with HRO Naples at the earliest opportunity, as provided in references (a) and (b).

5. Establishment of Competitive Areas. Competitive areas are the organizational and geographic boundaries in which employees compete for retention during a RIF. As required by reference (b), enclosure (1) lists competitive areas for RIF purposes for those commands/activities serviced by HRO Naples.
