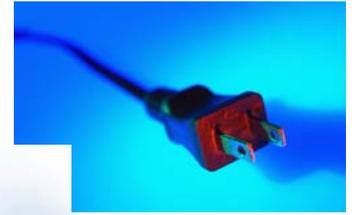

ENERGY CONSERVATION TIPS

Lighting

Turn-off unnecessary lighting in offices when not in use.
Use task lighting when available.
Turn-off lighting near windows during day hours to use natural light when available

Workstations

Turn-off power to monitor, don't just leave it in stand-by mode.

Copy Machines

Stand-by mode only turns off display, but still consumes same amount of power like idle mode, so completely turn off the machine until time of use.

Cooling Equipment

Turn off air condition equipment when the outside temperature is cooler than the inside temperature and open windows for natural cooling
