SUPPORT GUIDELINES FOR RHODE ISLAND SOUND

1. The sponsor shall designate a primary point of contact for on-site logistical support.
2. Parking must be within a reasonable distance to the performing site with additional access to any stage area.
3. Stage requirements are as follows:
 - a. Minimum stage area of 20 feet wide by 16 feet deep with adequate lighting.
 - b. Three separate 110-volt grounded outlets of at least 20 amps are required near the stage.
4. Performance Guidelines are as follows:
 - a. Performances shall not normally be scheduled prior to 0900.
 - b. Concert performances shall not normally exceed one hour.
 - c. Dance performances shall not normally exceed four hours.
 - d. Sufficient time must be available for setting up and removing equipment. One and one-half hours setup time is required prior to a performance for set-up and one hour after each performance for removal.
 - e. The band shall be limited to two performance sites per day.

5. Secure and private changing areas must be available for both male and female personnel.
