

Navy Family Ombudsman Registry

Commands are required to register, assign their ombudsman, and ensure that required worksheet data is submitted per [OPNAVINST 1750.1F](#). The Ombudsman Registry was established by Task Force Navy Family in August 2005 in response to the hurricanes in the Gulf Coast region. The registry allows CNIC to deliver real time communication and information to Commanders, Ombudsmen and Ombudsmen Coordinators. Detailed instructions and procedures are available for download on the "Welcome" page of the registry.

October Energy Challenge
Commands assigned to Naval Station Norfolk will compete against each other during the month of October to lower their electric bills. The three commands with the greatest difference from last October's electric bill will be given a minor work project of their choice valued at \$25K, \$15K and \$10K respectively.
Requirements:
1. Commands must sign up by COB 6 Oct.
2. Commands must select a BEM (Building Energy Monitor) to monitor energy usage, document conservation efforts and act as the POC for the Norfolk Energy Team.
3. BEM's must submit a write up explaining the process used to decrease their electric bill by 5 Nov.

NPPSC Command Timeliness

Naval Station PSDs (Ashore and Afloat) continually work with CNIC and NPPSC to improve timely preparation of pay affecting transactions but they need your help.
NPPSC commands are expected to process 97% of pay transactions within 30 days of the effective date of entitlement. Navy timeliness Command PASS Coordinators (CPC) are responsible for providing the appropriate documentation to their supporting PSD. Activity C.O.'s are requested to emphasize the importance of timely documentation submission to their respective command members and CPC.

Hampton Blvd. Detour Now Open

The new Hampton Blvd. detour is now open. The roadway, to the east, between B Ave. and Rogers Ave., will continue to facilitate traffic access along the Hampton Blvd. corridor to and from the installation.
