

Realignment of NAS Oceana Air Det Norfolk

Chambers Air Field, located at Naval Station Norfolk, has been operated by NAS Oceana Air Detachment Norfolk since the disestablishment of NAS Norfolk in February 1999. The 226 military and 30 civilian members have provided tenant squadrons with Air Traffic Control, Ground Electronic and flight line support. More than 300 transient aircraft are routinely handled each month by the Detachment in support of the Air Mobility Command. In the near future, the detachment will complete its' CNRMA directed realignment to Naval Station Norfolk Air Operations, ending Air Det's 11- year unique and historical command relationship with NAS Oceana.

Flight Hour Verification Requirement

Officer's not certifying Aviation Career Incentive Pay and Hazardous Duty Incentive Pay (ACIP) will see their entitlements stopped 31 DEC 11 and possible debts placed on the account. This is the large debt notification that was initiated last year by NPC and passed thru DFAS. This year there will be NO debt notification only stops and possible debts posted on the pay account. No separate letters will be issued and no grace period granted. Please see NAVADMIN 296/11 and if you have questions contact the POC listed on the NAVADMIN.

National EAS test

The first nationwide test of the Emergency Alert System will occur Nov. 9 at approximately 2 p.m. The test will include transmission by [FEMA](#) of a "live" Emergency Action Notification alert code to all EAS participants and notice to the general public that the EAS has been activated for a national emergency, along with an audible notice that "this is a test." The test will last approximately three minutes.
