## NAVY'S ECONOMIC IMPACT TO HAMPTON ROADS AREA REMAINS STRONG

*Norfolk, Va.* – Commander, Navy Region Mid-Atlantic has released an update to the fiscal year 2009 (Oct. 1, 2008 through Sept. 30, 2009) Department of the Navy impact statistical data for the Hampton Roads area.

Total direct economic impact to the region saw an increase of \$165 million in fiscal year 2009. Total annual payroll (military and civilian) also saw an increase from \$7.5 billion to \$8.2 billion. However, procurement expenditures decreased from approximately \$7.1 billion in FY08 to \$6.7 billion in FY09.

Operationally, the number of ships homeported in Hampton Roads decreased by one, from 84 to 83 with the decommissioning of the USNS Saturn (T-AFS-10) in April 2009. The number of aircraft squadrons increased by one, from 34 to 35 with the move of Helicopter Mine Counter Measures Squadron FIFTEEN (HM-15) from Naval Air Station Corpus Christi to Naval Station Norfolk, in accordance with the 2005 Base Realignment and Closure (BRAC) recommendations.
