

Midshipmen Summer Training

Commencing in Mid-May, NSN Navy Gateway Inns and Suites and ships will host hundreds of NROTC and USNA midshipmen over the summer. These young and impressionable service members will be interacting with us in the Galley, in MWR facilities, in barracks, in our work spaces, and on liberty. Turn Your Lights Out – Save Energy

The Naval Station Norfolk Energy and Utility Management Program Instruction 4100.1 was recently signed. All NSN tenant commands and NSN departments shall comply with current energy management guidance in a manner that does not compromise military readiness, safety, and Quality of life (QOL). NSN initiated a new energy governance board to recommend and implement actions that move our base toward more effective energy management. Each worker aboard NSN will be asked to contribute toward these goals in the coming months. As a reminder, facilities office spaces shall maintain a minimum temperature 76°F.

HURREX 2010

Naval Station Norfolk will participate in U.S. Fleet Forces Command (USFF) and Commander Navy Installations Command (CNIC) hurricane preparedness exercise, HURREX/Citadel Gale 10, from May 3-13. The exercise will involve two simulated storm systems developing and intensifying to hurricane strength, threatening the Caribbean Islands, East Coast, and Gulf Coast regions. All Navy commands with personnel in these regions will participate, to include reviewing and exercising heavy weather instructions and procedures and accounting for Sailors and Navy families in the affected regions through the Navy Family Accountability and Assessment System (NFAAS).
