

Motorcycle Safety P-4 from RADM Boensel, CNRMA

Over the last two years Navy sportbike riders have steadily increased to over 11,000 riders. To date only 8,000 have received the required training. We need to close that gap. So far this year USN has suffered nine motorcycle fatalities, all but one on sportbikes. Of those, only one rider had completed both the Basic Rider Course (BRC) and the Military Sportbike Rider Course (MSRC).

ELECTRONIC LEAVE (e-Leave)

Per NAVADMIN 103/10 all shore commands will start using e-Leave application in August 2010. Sailors' leave requests will be generated, routed, and leave days charged within e-Leave. The application will be accessed (<https://nsips.nmci.navy.mil>) via the NSIPS Self-Service Electronic Service Record (ESR) account that all active-duty and reserve personnel were required to establish per NAVADMIN 043/09. Each command will have to designate Command Leave Administrator (CLA) (July 2010) who will be responsible for the management of the command leave program. Ensure your CLA has received training.
