

Centennial of Naval Aviation

Although Naval Station Norfolk wasn't established until 1917, Naval aviation began here on Nov. 14, 1910. Eugene Burton Ely, a civilian pilot from Iowa, became the first man to take off from the deck of a ship. He flew a Curtiss Model D bi-plane from a platform constructed on the bow of the cruiser USS BIRMINGHAM and landed 21/2 miles away on Willoughby Spit. Two months later, on January 18, 1911, Ely successfully executed the first airplane landing on a ship in the San Francisco Bay. In 1933, President Herbert Hoover recognized the significance of Ely's contributions by posthumously awarding him the Distinguished Flying Cross.
