

TPU Briefing

TPU Norfolk will conduct a briefing to the Fleet to assist in expediting their Sailors' receipt and processing through TPU pipelines at 0900, 9 Feb. The brief will include: For Further Transportation (onward transportation to deployed and overseas-based units), limited duty, pregnancy, regular separation, administrative separation, discipline (including returned UAs/deserters, and certain court-martial personnel). The briefing will be held at TPU Norfolk, building J-50, 1683 Gilbert Street.

The briefing will outline requirements of each process, clarify misconceptions, and prepare legal teams and admin departments for the unexpected ramifications that ultimately slow down the Sailors' transition.

I wanted to ensure everyone is aware that Solid Curtain-Citadel Shield (SC-CS), the Navy's major annual Anti-Terrorism/Force Protection (ATFP) exercise, will be conducted on 22-25 February. SC-CS is USFFC-directed, CONUS-wide and will affect all Naval installations, units, activities and Sailors in the USNORTHCOM AOR. Changes in Force Protection Conditions (FPCON) may impact base access, parking, access to certain facilities, increased vehicle searches etc. Leadership recognizes that "business as usual" will also be impacted, but this is essential to ensure a true evaluation of AT readiness and capabilities is achieved. Wide Area Alert Network

Sailors and Civilians assigned to Navy installations can receive alert messages relating to emergency information, inclement weather, crisis events and road closings through the Commander, Navy Installation Command (CNIC) Shore Wide Area Alert Network or WAAN system.

All NMCI users must manually register their emergency contact information in order to receive the telephone, e-mail or text notifications. These notifications can be received on personal cell phones, home phones and via personal e-mails. Click for [instructions](#) on how to register.

Disaster Preparedness Brief

Naval Station Norfolk will host an emergency preparedness presentation on 8 Feb, in the bldg. C-9 auditorium.

NAVSTA Norfolk Emergency Manager will present on topics including upcoming installation wide exercises, NAVSTA Norfolk EM plan, preparing facility emergency action plans, evacuations, and the installation warning and notification system.

NAVSTA Norfolk's Anti-Terrorism Officer will also provide a brief on what NAVSTA Norfolk tenant commands can expect during exercise Solid Curtain/Citadel Shield, to be conducted 22-25 Feb.

On-Base Dialing

When placing calls from the 322, 444, 445 prefix use the 5-digit dialing feature available at Naval Station Norfolk (dial 2-, 4- or 5- and the last four digits of the phone number). Use of 5-digit dialing will greatly reduce traffic in the outgoing trunks, which reduces cost. For all other prefixes, dial 9 then the 7 digit number.
