Article 32 hearing for Navy Chief begins Friday

Norfolk – An Article 32 hearing for Chief Information Systems Technician Rodney Williams, who has been accused of murder, will take place at the Regional Legal Assistance Office, July 15 at 8 a.m.

Like a civilian preliminary hearing, the purpose is to consider the form of the charges and make a recommendation to the convening authority as to the disposition of the charges. Media interested in attending the Article 32 should contact the Public Affairs Office at 757-322-2853 no later 4 p.m. Thursday, July 14.

Media should arrive at the Naval Station Tour & Information Center (9079 Hampton Blvd.) no later than at 7 a.m., Friday, for credentialing.

No television or still cameras, recording devices, or cell phones will be allowed inside the courtroom.
