

Change in Access Control Policy Effective 1 August 2011

Effective 01 August 2011 NAS Oceana and the Regional Contractor Badges will no longer be issued to vendors, contractors, sub-contractors and outside service providers. All Contractor Badges that were issued prior to these changes will expire on their expiration date or 01 October 2011, whichever occurs first. For vendors, contractors, sub-contractors and service providers who regularly access NAVSTA Norfolk for business and do not rate a Common Access Card (CAC), the only two authorized methods for access will be with the Navy Commercial Access Control System (NCACS/RAPIDGate) credential or a Day Pass. Individuals that enroll in NCACS will have streamlined access and those that choose not to enroll will have restricted and limited access onto the installation. NAS Oceana appreciates your continued support of our efforts to make this installation safer and more secure.

Below are the changes in access:

NCACS Participants Benefits:

- Long-term access (90 days to 1 year)
- Access through all gates that vehicle size allows

Non-NCACS Participant (Contractor Pass) Restrictions

- Limited to 1-day access
- Limited access times between the hours of 0600 – 1645 M-F

Key Dates:

- On 1 August NAS Oceana and the Regional Contractor Badges will no longer be issued
- All Contractor Badges that were issued prior to these changes will expire on their expiration date or 01 October 2011 or whichever occurs first.
- After 1 October only CACs, NCACS Credentials, Day Passes and TWICs with a Bill of Lading will be valid for perimeter access onto the installation for Vendors/Contractors.
