Mission essential only to report to work Monday

Norfolk, VA (CNRMA) – Yesterday the Navy ordered most installations from North Carolina to Maine to set Tropical Cyclone Condition Two to prepare for Hurricane Irene, forecasted to impact the Mid-Atlantic Coast on Saturday evening.

To facilitate recovery from the storm and hurricane damage repairs, Commander, Navy Region Mid-Atlantic has direct Mission Essential Personnel only to report to Navy installations in Hampton Roads, as well as Surface Combat Systems Center Wallops Island on Monday, August 29.

Military personnel and their families are encouraged to stay tuned to local television and radio stations for updated information.
