Hampton Roads Armed Forces Motorcycle Rally

Norfolk, VA-- Naval Station Norfolk will hold the annual Hampton Roads Armed Forces Motorcycle Rally May 18. The ride's festivities will commence at 8:30 a.m. in the parking lot at Main Gate Theater and will include music, concessions, door prizes, discount cards and motorcycle gear sales for riders and spectators.

“We expect 200-300 active duty, DoD, retired military and family members from all services throughout the Hampton Roads community to participate in this motorcycle safety event, which will be in a poker-run format” said Master Chief David Carter, Command Master Chief, Naval Station Norfolk.

The scenic and technically challenging bike route, which begins at Naval Station Norfolk, will take approximately 90 minutes for groups to complete. The route spans Interstate 64 to U.S. Route 17 to Northwest Annex, over to Southside Harley-Davidson, and back to Naval Station Norfolk. Ride groups will be limited to 10-15 riders per group with a volunteer rider coach/road captain in each group. Single riders will be assigned to a group based upon riding experience.
