

Towing/Hitch Requirements for Trailers

19 foot Trailer

1. Truck capable of towing 6500 lbs. or more
2. Permanently mounted Class 2 hitch assembly w/ safety chain hook-up points
3. 2" square receiver
4. 7 round electrical plug for power from truck to trailer (recreational type, not industrial)
5. Electric brake controller (under dashboard) or electric brake wire plug that you can attach our brake controller to and mount it under the dash
6. Proof of comprehensive collision insurance to cover replacement cost of trailer in case of accident.

Viking Tent Trailer

1. Vehicle capable of towing 2000 lbs. or more
2. Permanently mounted Class 2 hitch assembly w/ safety chain hook-up points
3. 2" ball
4. 7 round electrical plug for power from truck to trailer (recreational type, not industrial) *Note:* Since our Tent Trailer does not have electric brakes, we do have adapters that convert 7-plug to a flat 4-plug.
5. Proof of comprehensive collision insurance to cover replacement cost of trailer in case of accident.

Boat & Canoe Trailers

1. Vehicle capable of towing 1000 lbs. or more
2. Permanently mounted Class 2 hitch assembly w/ safety chain hook-up points
3. 2" ball
4. Flat 4 wiring plug
5. Proof of comprehensive collision insurance to cover replacement cost of boat, canoe and/or trailer in case of accident.
