


Emotional Cycle of Deployment



K - 12 Transition Checklist:

The School Liaison Officer (SLO) is the central point of contact for school related matters between NRNW Commands, military families, and local school systems. The SLO specializes in serving military students and families, and offers a wide spectrum of services to include:

6 Core Functions of SLO

1. School Transition Services
2. Deployment Support
3. Command, School, Community Communications
4. Home School Linkage and Support
5. Partnerships in Education
6. Post-Secondary Preparation

(Eligibility for School Liaison Officer Services: SLOs serve families of active duty, guard, reservists and civilian employees of all military branches.)

- Resources on local schools
- Public, private, home school choice options
- Special needs district and community contacts
- Washington State Core Graduation Requirements
- Military and community resources
