Air station, county staff discuss future land use around NAS

Monroe County planning staff and county attorneys met with Naval Air Station Key West personnel Monday at NAS' Boca Chica Field as part of the continuing dialogue between the two entities regarding compatible land use around the base.

Community Plans and Liaison Officer (CPLO) Gail Kenson scheduled the meeting after NAS Key West Business Manager Ron Demes requested the staffs meet outside county commission and planning

meetings to resolve any misconceptions regarding what NAS is looking for as the county updates its comprehensive plan, which addresses future land-use planning around the air station. Additional individual meetings have been scheduled with county commissioners and NAS Key West Commanding Officer Capt. Patrick Lefere.

The main topic of the meeting was the air station's 2007 Air Installations Compatible Use Zones (AICUZ) study, which is a land-use planning tool for the county to use and constitutes the air station's source of the most relevant

and up-to-date data on aircraft operations. The study also contains recommendations for compatible land uses considering anticipated noise levels, accident potential zones and obstruction clearance criteria associated with NAS' airfield operations. The previous AICUZ study was completed in 1977 and the 2007 study update rendered it obsolete. NAS Key West has requested that the county use the data from the 2007 AICUZ study, vice 1977, for its land-use compatibility criteria in the comprehensive plan.

"The county has refused to use the most recent study cit-

ing it as an invalid document and has said, 'adoption of the 2007 AICUZ map without the benefit of a full evaluation of impacts through the Navy's EIS process would be premature,'" Demes explained. "The Navy stands behind the latest study, which was completed using the latest methodology for describing noise exposure, but we've had difficulty getting the county to separate their perceived impacts from the relevance of the modeled data."

Kenson said that the meetings have been a good forum to air issues from both entities.

Building resiliency in transitioning children

Twenty-five educators, counselors, youth service providers and parents gathered at the Doubletree Resort in Key West last week for an excellent two-day professional development activity, called Transition Counselor Institute, Phase Two. Attendees came from Sigsbee Charter School, Key West High School, Naval Air Station Key West Fleet and Family Services and MWR Child and Youth Programs.

Transition Counselor Institutes (TCIs) are interactive professional development opportunities, delivered by the Military Child Education Coalition (MCEC), and focusing on dealing effectively with the social and emotional challenges for children and youth in military transitions. In the summer of 2010, TCI, Phase One, was held in Key West. Participants felt that the experience was so valuable that they asked the school liaison officer to arrange to have the MCEC trainers return this year. Included in the sessions were information, resources and conversations about

mobility, deployment and separation, school support systems; confidence and resilience, family support systems, teaching and guiding professional colleagues and setting up an inviting school culture. The

trainers from MCEC were interesting and effective, and the materials they shared will be useful for the participants

"We think that having face-to-face meetings and a healthy dialogue will go a long way toward a compromise that ultimately will protect the health, safety and welfare of the residents near the air station, which is what an AICUZ study helps the county to do," said Kenson. "This particular meeting was very productive and gave the county planners an opportunity to hear our concerns, without hearing about it through the media or only at county and planning commission meetings."

Monroe County Growth Management Division Director Christine Hurley attended Monday's meeting and said that she thought the meeting accomplished a lot.

"I left the meeting feeling both sides can work together to develop policy language that can accomplish protection from future impacts that may better the community and the conditions in which future development may occur adjacent to or near NASKW," she wrote in an email. "This

dialog at a staff level enhanced each group's understanding of issues faced by the other group. Continued discussions, as well as increased communication between our elected officials and NAS, is the only way we are going to develop policy that can be adopted into the county's comprehensive plan to address land use compatibility in a manner that will work for both sides."

Demes, who is also an ex-officio member of the county's planning commission, summed up NAS Key West's stand on incorporating current data into the county's comprehensive plan.

"Naval Air Station Key West has a mission to conduct in support of the National Defense Strategy," Demes said. "While conducting that mission and ensuring safety of flight, we are also charged with protecting the health, safety and welfare of Monroe County citizens and visitors. Through continuing dialog with the local governments and community our goals remains incorporating compatibility criteria into the local comprehensive plan to provide long-term encroachment protection."

Special Duty Assignment Pay recertification

Annual Special Duty Assignment Pay (SDAP) recertification is 50 percent complete across the fleet as this month's deadline nears, Navy officials announced Aug. 12.

"As of today we are half-way complete with 678 commands remaining," said Navy Personnel Command (NPC) Force Master Chief (AW/SW/NAC) Jon Port. "With the Aug. 31 deadline approaching, we want commands to submit their recertification to ensure success and continued benefit to their eligible Sailors."

Recertification is typically completed by a command's admin department or personnel officer.

SDAP is an incentive pay ranging from \$75 to \$450 a month used to entice qualified personnel to accept designated assignments and to

sustain adequate manning levels. In order to qualify for SDAP, Sailors must be assigned to and working in a valid billet on the command Manpower Authorization Listing. This billet must be authorized by the Bureau of Naval Personnel as a Special Duty Assignment billet.

SDAP recertification is conducted annually to ensure commands are maintaining an accurate account of member's eligibility for SDAP.

Recertification began in June with the release of

NAVADMIN198/11 and NPC must receive recertification by Aug. 31. Recertification procedures are outlined in the message.

More than 25,000 Sailors currently receive SDAP. Sailors can read OPNAVINST 1160.6 and talk with their command career counselor to learn more about SDAP.

mounting partition walls for bathrooms, and stripping and cleaning tile floors in classrooms and administrative offices.

The school also has to be upgraded for safety and disability requirements. Petty officers Jeremy Tellier and John Smith helped other civilian volunteers make improvements to meet those requirements and assist in the safety and health issues that need to be fixed prior to the school's first day. They worked to make bathroom stalls accessible for wheelchairs and they mounted door handles and safety bars for physically-challenged students. EOON Louis Torres supported the effort by painting classrooms and offices.

"It's all about the kids," said UT2 Cody Woitena. "I'm very

excited to be there helping the school and creating a better learning environment for young kids."

Sigsbee Charter School first opened for the 2010 school year. It is located in the legacy Sigsbee Elementary School facility, in the heart of Naval Air Station Key West's Sigsbee Park Annex. It opened as a K-5 elementary school and will expand by one grade level each year, until it becomes a K-8 elementary and middle school.

According to an email from Commander, First Naval Construction Division, CBMU 202 Det. Key West will be disestablished Sept. 30 and its cadre of 48 personnel transferred to other units in the

Naval Construction Force. The detachment's equipment and tools will be returned to its parent command, CBMU 202, and its other detachments.

Ventilation in the workplace

Jane Doe sits at her desk wearing a ski hat, gloves and a scarf. A space heater is operating nearby. Meanwhile, her boss, Johnny Diamond, sits in his office at the other end of the floor and frequently opens his window to let the winter air cool off his sweltering office, or for summer everyone opens windows to try to cool off.

This is a typical workplace

scenario that our energy team deals with. Keeping an office comfortable for employees is very difficult, since "comfortable" means something different to everyone. We deal and live with old buildings with uneven heating and cooling systems and it's possible to have one office - one room, even many rooms with several climates. We are working on getting this straightened out, but need your help.

The cause of the problem is that Johnny has his windows open causing Jane to bundle up and stay warm by her heater. The solution is to maintain the heating in the building by shutting the windows and shutting off portable heaters.

Jane had the right idea. She brought extra clothing to keep her warm on a day that it may be a little bit colder. Same goes for Johnny; He should wear thinner clothing to stay cool and have some heavier clothing in case he gets cold.

The worst situation and trend is when occupants, customers or you in the workplace take matters into your own hands and make adjustments to the ventilation system. There are many tech-savvy people, but the problem is when the air flow is reduced from one area the air is going somewhere else. This makes others uncomfortable and you can see how this can get out of hand. We all may know someone that has made these self adjustments, and this needs to stop. Please call it in to your building manager for a fix. We will try to isolate the problems

to make the buildings work as they should.

The goal is to maintain a comfortable temperature in the workplace. Portable heaters during the winter and air conditioning units in the summer will change the heating

system so that it increases or decreases the building temperature, making the temperature comfortable for one and uncomfortable for others. This also increases the energy usage for the buildings, and the ever increasing cost of utilities is raising your bills.

Listed below are the temperature settings for the Navy. Following these setting will help keep the workplace within reason and it will save energy and money.

- Heating season office spaces: 68 degrees heating set point.
- Cooling season office spaces: 78 degrees cooling set point.

U. S. Coast Guard Cutter Mohawk changes command

U. S. Coast Guard Cutter Mohawk held a change of command ceremony at Coast Guard Sector Key West Aug. 11.

Cmdr. Mark J. Fedor became the Mohawk's 12th commanding officer, relieving Cmdr. Robert T. Hendrickson during the military ceremony.

Coast Guard Atlantic Area Commander Vice Adm. Robert C. Parker presided over the change of command and awarded Hendrickson the Meritorious Service Medal recognizing his service and performance of duty aboard Mohawk.

During Hendrickson's two-year command, the cutter

spanned 50,000 miles and three continents. Most notable, his crew responded to the devastating earthquake in Haiti within 24 hours and further, deployed to Africa in support of the Navy's Sixth Fleet and U.S. Africa Command. In addition, the crew yielded three drug busts netting more than \$133 million.

Hendrickson is headed for the 14th Coast Guard District in Honolulu to become the chief of law enforcement.

Fedor reports to the Mohawk from Washington, D.C., where he earned a master's degree in National Security Strategy from the National War College.

The cutter Mohawk is a 270-foot medium-endurance cutter homeported in Key West.



Detailers review adjustments for projected rotation dates

Naval Personnel Command announced Wednesday that more than 60,000 Sailors will see their projected rotation date (PRD) adjusted as Navy Personnel Command (NPC) implements new Sea Shore Flow enlisted career paths.

"Detailers are currently reviewing Sailors records and making PRD adjustments as required," said Capt. Michael White, assistant commander, NPC for Career Management. "Once all of the PRD adjustments have been completed a formal notification will be issued and commands can review their EDVR (enlisted distribution and verification report) for the changes."


Navy administrative message (NAVADMIN) 201/11, released July 2011 announced revisions to Sea Shore Flow reflecting the increasingly sea-

centric nature of naval service.

Thirty-six ratings have increased sea time, and 18 ratings are now classified as sea intensive. Specific Sea Shore Flow timelines for individual ratings are listed by rating in the NAVADMIN, which can be found at www.public.navy.mil/bopers-npc/reference/messages/Documents/NAVADMINS/NAV2011/NAV11201.txt.

"Since 2008, the number of sea duty billets has increased, while the number of shore duty billets has decreased," said White. "The updated career paths provide optimal balance between sea duty and shore duty enhances stability and improves predictability of the career paths for every Sailor in a sea-centric Navy."

According to White, Sailors with PRDs prior to May 2012 will not have their current PRD adjusted under the new Sea Shore Flow calculations. Rating detailers at NPC will determine what PRD adjustments

all other Sailors will face based on the new guidance and fleet readiness. White says the adjustments will impact 60,150 Sailors and expects adjustments will be complete Sept. 1.

Sea Shore Flow was first implemented in 2008 to replace pay-grade driven Sea Shore Rotation. Sea Shore Flow was made to help ensure proper manning of all sea duty

and front line operational billets. At the same time, it helps to provide a more desirable work-life balance throughout a Sailor's career by working to offset the often arduous nature of sea duty with predictable periods of meaningful work ashore.

lines, frequently asked questions, and ERB news stories and videos.

It can be found on NPC's homepage under "Boards" or at www.npc.navy.mil/boards/ERB.

As a result of record-high retention and low attrition among active duty Sailors and to meet current and future planned end strength controls, the Navy will conduct a focused ERB for 31 specific ratings that are more than 103 percent manned.

According to Navy administrative message (NAVADMIN) 129/11, the board will examine the performance of approximately 16,000 Sailors. An estimated 3,000 Sailors will not be retained on active duty but will be encouraged to apply for the Selected Reserve, if not accepted for rate conversion.

Estimated ERB quotas were posted Aug. 1, which can also be found on the new Web page.

The final update of estimated ERB quotas will be released with the precept after the board convenes.



Program supports military families with special needs

About a year ago, Air Force Maj. Nicholas Sabula received word of an upcoming assignment following his deployment in Afghanistan.

He became concerned, however, when he learned that his new duty station and the local area didn't have adequate services for his son, who was diagnosed with autism in 2006. But shortly after, based on a recommendation from his Exceptional Family Member Program coordinator, Sabula's assignment was cancelled and he moved here instead.

"The benefit to our son was tremendous," he said. "It showed the availability of services at one location versus another can make an incredible impact on that child."

Ensuring military families with special medical and educational needs receive the best care and support possible is

the goal of the Exceptional Family Member Program, said Rebecca Posante, deputy director of the department's office of community support for military families with special needs.

The program assists these families with everything from assignments, as in Sabula's case, to referrals for military and community resources, Posante said, with a focus on three key areas: identification and enrollment, assignment coordination and family support.

Family members - whether a spouse, child or dependent adult - with a chronic medical condition or special educational requirement are eligible to enroll, Posante explained. Conditions run the gamut, she noted, covering everything from asthma and allergies to autism and Alzheimer's disease.

"If you've got something that requires you to see someone beyond your family doc-

tor, you probably should come and see if you need to be enrolled," she advised.

Once enrolled, the service member's records would include a "flag," Posante explained, which serves as an alert that the member's family may need special consideration when up for an assignment, whether stateside or overseas.

"There may be places where if a family member has a particular issue, it may not be advisable for you to go to this area," she noted, citing asthma as an example. The condition might be fine at one location, but exacerbated at another, she explained. Or, a child or spouse may need a specialized orthopedic program that's only offered in limited locations.

The program also helps to avoid treatment disruptions, Posante noted. If a cancer patient is undergoing treatment at one base, a program coordinator can recommend

that patient not be moved until therapy is completed.

When notified of a move or upon arrival, Posante recommended families contact their local installation family support providers.

These providers help families identify and access programs and services, both on base and within the community. Their services include information and referrals for military and community services, local school information, referral to other family center providers, and education and training about issues related to the special need. The support providers also provide a "warm hand-off" to the gaining installation, she said, by sending information, with the family's permission, to the program contact there.

Military families who aren't near an installation, including those of the National Guard and Reserve, can call a Military OneSource consul-

tant for support and to discuss special-needs concerns. Families can receive 12 free consultations per year by calling 1-800-342-9647 or by visiting the OneSource website.

These providers help families identify and access programs and services, both on base and within the community.

More than 120,000 military families with special needs are enrolled in the program, but Posante said there could be twice that many with enrolable conditions, ranging from the minor to the severe. She'd like to see more service members enroll so they can receive the care and support their families need. "It's in their benefit, their family's benefit, to be enrolled," she said.
