

NAVAL STATION MAYPORT REGULATIONS FOR PET OWNERSHIP IN ALL BASE HOUSING

1. Ownership of a pet while station at NAVSTAMYPT is a privilege, and is dependant upon the owner's proper care for the animal, the animal's ability to live harmoniously within the community, and the owner's ability to pay all costs associated with pet ownership.

2. All pets must be registered with NAVSTAMYPT Security Department in Building 1591 within 30 days of reporting on board or moving into Government Housing, per NAVSTAMYPT Instruction 10570.1. To help readily indentify lost dogs and cats, pet owners are **advised** to have a micro-chip implanted into their domestic dog or cat at the on-base Veterinary Treatment Facility (VTF).

a. Failure to register a pet will result in a warning letter. Non-compliance will result in a revocation of the pet owner's privilege.

3. All animals outside must be on a leash, or tethered to a permanently fixed object the animal is incapable of moving. Animals outside must be attended and physically supervised by a responsible adult.

a. Screened porches, garages and fenced in areas in yards are not to be used as kennels. Garage areas are not to be used for animals at any time due to heat conditions.

4. Pet owner's failure to comply with the outlined responsibilities will jeopardize the owner's privilege of owning a pet on NAVSTAMYPT.
