ITT Office helps customers realize their dream vacations

The Information, Tickets and Travel Office provides attraction tickets, hotel rooms and cruises at a discounted price. The ITT office



also is a resource for on base and local information. While some attractions are military-specific discounts, ITT also has discounts available for DoD Civilians and Contractors.

ITT schedules and operates bus trips. These trips are open to all eligible MWR patrons. The next trip that ITT will be offering is a trip to the Pearl River Resort in Philadelphia on November 18th. The bus departs at 1815 and the cost per person is \$15.00. This is being offered alongside the School Age Children and Child Development Center's "Family Night Out." This will provide childcare for the parents who then can enjoy a night out at the casino. Along with ITT's scheduled trips, ITT also has buses available for rent. Buses and MWR drivers are available to provide transportation for on base groups and clubs. Registration for both ITT scheduled trips and special interest groups is done at the ITT office.

Disney and Universal Studios tickets are a popular item at the ITT office. Disney's "Military Salute" is a four day Park Hopper ticket available to military patrons. The general public price for these tickets is over \$300.00 per ticket. Eligible military patrons can purchase up to six of these tickets for \$138.00 each. Along with the Salute tickets, Disney also offers a military discount on their resort rooms. Military patrons can save between 20-40% booking their room at the military rate through ITT. Disney's military special will continue through September 2012. Discounted Geyser Falls and Six Flags over Georgia tickets were another top seller over the summer. Although these attractions




