

Information on Local Schools

Monterey County is vast and diverse as can be seen in its 24 school districts and 134 schools registered with the Monterey County Office of Education. School placement in the county is based on where you live. Families living in Military Housing in La Mesa Village or Fort Ord Military Community will be zoned for [Monterey Peninsula Unified School District \(MPUSD\)](#). MPUSD serves local students living in the nearby cities of Monterey, Seaside, Del Ray and Marina. Families living “off base” and not in MPUSD boundaries will most likely be zoned for one of the two closest school districts, [Pacific Grove Unified School District](#) or [Carmel Unified School District](#).
