DON OBSERVANCE OF CONSTITUTION DAY AND CITIZENSHIP DAY

September 17 has been designated as Constitution Day and Citizenship Day to commemorate the signing of the Constitution in Philadelphia on September 17, 1787.



Federal agencies observe Constitution Day/ Citizenship Day on September 17 each year. In the spirit of this observance, NRSW has determined that all personnel should take the Department of Defense U. S. Constitution course. This on-line course is located at <https://twms.nmci.navy.mil/selfservice/> Click on on-line training and then scroll down to Constitution Day Training.

The purpose of this course is to help employees to increase awareness of major political events that necessitated the writing of the Constitution, to identify the basic concepts embodied in the constitution, and recall the direct link that DoD employees have with the constitution.
