1.	New registration requirements include mandatory middle initial, date of birth, completion of DD Form 2760, and Hazard Safety brief.	TRUE	FALSE	
2.	Any number of shotguns may be registered and you may bring any number desired on base on any hunting day as long as they are registered..	TRUE	FALSE	
3.	Blinds are assigned on a priority basis on hunting days prescribed in NBVC Environmental Procedure "Waterfowl Hunting Annual Information – Dates and Times". On any other day during the waterfowl season in Southern California blinds aboard NBVC Point Mugu may be used on a first come basis.	TRUE	FALSE	
4.	Primary phone number for waterfowl Information (including blind assignments or cancellations) is the duty Waterfowl Committee representative at <u>805-890-7245</u>	TRUE	FALSE
