



Learn the hidden secrets that Oahu has to offer include drive routes, hiking locations, beaches etc. We will end the trip with a relaxing swim at one of our favorite beaches. (Date: 2/25)

BOTTOM FISHING

Enjoy an afternoon of fun and relaxation on the water with the Outdoor Recreation staff, as you try your skills at bringing in the big one. You never know what you might catch. A wide variety of reef fish and a token shark or two are ready to put you to the test. We'll provide the fishing gear, bait, and boat, along with some instructions. You provide the luck! Catch and release or take them home for dinner. This trip is great for beginners as well as the seasoned veteran. (Dates: 2/12, 2/25, 3/10, 3/25, 4/15)

DAY HIKE AIEA LOOP

A local favorite, the Aiea loop offers excellent views and peaceful sounds of birds and running streams. Traverse through bamboo and ferns and hunt for strawberry guava. Water, sun block and snacks are recommended for this hike. (Date: 2/26)

"Kaena" is known as the place of heat, so bring plenty of water! Trip includes transportation and wild and crazy (fun) guides. (Date: 2/18)

DAY HIKE AT KOKO HEAD CRATER

Join us as we take on this popular adventure to the top of Koko Head Crater. Once an active volcano, this hike promises great views. Along the way is a narrow rock arch and a chance at whale watching. At the top are panoramic views of East Oahu and the remains of an incline railway. (Date: 3/4)

DAY HIKE MARINER'S RIDGE

The Outdoor Adventure staff is out and about as they head to the high country. SPEAR FISHING 102

(Prerequisite Spear Fishing 101)
Spear fishing 102 is for those who have taken the 101 class or are accomplished free divers that want to jump on our boat for the adventure. This dive lasts about 3 hours. Depending on the skill level, we usually do the 1st dive in shallow water, 6 to 12 feet deep on the next back at our boat to discuss the dive. The 2nd dive is in water about 10 to 20 feet deep depending on the diver's ability. Even if you are unable to spear any fish, you'll have a blast just being out there! 
