JOINT BASE PEARL HARBOR-HICKAM**

- **Patriot Day Remembrance Ceremony, Friday, Sept. 9, 7:30-8:00 a.m.**

There will be a KC-135 aircraft flyover and more than 1,500 members of Team Hickam will be in attendance. - **Hickam Elementary School Parade, Friday, Sept. 9, 9:00–10:00 a.m.**
