

1. Pontoon Boat Reservation – Sumay Cove Marina 564-1846

- Reservations may be made up to 90 days in advance.
- 24 hour notice for cancellation or rescheduling
- A 50% non refundable deposit is required when making a reservation. This deposit will be applied to the rental fee. A reservation may be rescheduled with more than 24 hours advance notice with out losing your deposit.
- No boat rentals if there is a small craft advisory issued, or the marina management decides the weather and or sea conditions are unsafe for boating.

Cancellation Charge

- Same day cancellations or, no show, for boat rental reservation will result in full payment of boat rental price. If the reservation date is required to change because of weather or boat conditions not permitting rental, the reservation may be rescheduled with no penalties or the deposit be refunded. The marina management is the approving authority on weather cancellations.

Late Return Penalty Fee

- Boats returned later than 20minutes past the reserved hour will be subject to a \$30.00 penalty fee. Plus an additional \$30.00 per hour thereafter.

2. Rules

Absolutely no drinking for the operator of the boat. If you come to the dock and it is evident you have been drinking your license for all boats will be terminated.

- You are responsible for everyone on board. So keep everyone safe and under control.
- This is not a performance boat by any means so go slow and cruise. 3500 RPM max.
- Kids older than 1 year old on the pontoon are ok. All other boats are 3yrs old and up.
- All kids under 13 are required to wear a life jacket at all times.
- 10 people max on pontoon including kids
- 4 scuba tanks max. Tanks and Gear must stay off of the seats. Scuba gear has to be removed while in the water. Do not climb up the ladder with scuba gear on.
- A dive flag must be visible when people are in the water.
- The only dock the boat is permitted to use is at Sumay Cove unless an emergency requires otherwise.
- Fishing – Jigs only. No cut bait unless you can absolutely prove you will keep it off the carpet. Keep fish in a cooler and the boat clean at all times.
- No barbeque or open flames.
- Do not throw **anything** overboard, including food trash. All trash must be kept on board until dockside.
- Use moorings as much as possible and minimize anchoring.
- Keep the boat loaded evenly from front to back.
- Keep the boat clean and take care of the boat as if it were your own.
- No rafting or tying other boats along side.

3. Float Plan

- Must be filled out completely in detail before leaving the Marina
- Leave a good cell phone number
- Sign rental agreement

4. Area of Operation

- **Inside Apra Harbor Only**, no further west than Finger Reef and American Tanker.
- No Boating or anchoring near Gab Gab or San Luis beaches.
- Stay clear of Kilo Warf and all Ships, Subs, charter boats, etc... Observe the rules of the road and use caution while boating.

If you are observed or reported outside the area of operation your license will be suspended
