

### 1. Boston Whaler Reservation – Sumay Cove Marina 564-1846.

- Reservations may be made up to 90 days in advance.
- 24 hour notice for cancellation or rescheduling
- A 50% non refundable deposit is required when making a reservation. This deposit will be applied to the rental fee. A reservation may be rescheduled with more than 24 hours advance notice with out losing your deposit.
- No boat rentals if there is a small craft advisory issued, or the marina management decides the weather and or sea conditions are unsafe for boating.

#### Cancellation Charge

- Same day cancellations or, no show, for boat rental reservation will result in full payment of boat rental price. If the reservation date is required to change because of weather or boat conditions not permitting rental, the reservation may be rescheduled with no penalties or the deposit be refunded. The marina management is the approving authority on weather cancellations.

#### Late Return Penalty Fee

- Boats returned later than 20minutes past the reserved hour will be subject to a \$30.00 penalty fee. Plus an additional \$30.00 per hour thereafter.

### 2. Rules

**Absolutely no drinking for the operator of the boat. If you come to the dock and it is evident you have been drinking your license for all boats will be terminated.**

- You are responsible for everyone on board. So keep everyone safe and under control.
- Minimum of 2 people on board, max of 6 people.
- If Scuba diving max is 4 divers with 2 tanks plus a qualified boat operator. Boat operator must stay on board with a dive flag visible. Use care with scuba tanks, do not bang the boat.
- No kids younger than 3 years old. Anyone under 13 must wear a life jacket at all times.
- Keep fishing lines out of the prop. If you do get line wrapped up notify staff. Watch out for other boats pulling fishing lines.
- Keep the bilges dry. Run the pump for 5 min every 30 min. Not continuously
- No bow riding. Keep all body parts inside the boat. Even while docking.
- The only dock the boat is permitted to use is at Sumay Cove unless an emergency requires otherwise.
- Keep fish in a cooler, not in the deck boxes, and keep the boat clean at all times or you will clean it later.
- No barbeque or open flames.
- Do not throw **anything** overboard, including food trash. All trash must be kept on board until dockside.
- Use moorings as much as possible and minimize anchoring.
- No wake speed inside Sumay Marina. Remember you are responsible for your wake.
- Load the boat loaded evenly.
- Take care of the boat as if it were your own.

### 3. Float Plan

- Must be filled out completely in detail before leaving the Marina
- Leave a good cell phone number
- Sign rental agreement

### 4. Area of Operation.

- The whalers are not meant for open ocean use. **No further than one mile off shore, northern boundary is Double Reef, southern boundary is Cocos Island, but stay out of Cocos Lagoon.**
- No Boating or anchoring on or near Gab Gab or San Luis beaches
- Beware of fire and danger zone, its signal flags, and were you cannot be while the firing range is hot.
- Stay clear of Kilo Warf and all Ships, Subs, charter boats, etc... Observe the rules of the road and use caution while boating.

**If you are observed or reported outside the area of operation your license will be suspended.**
