PARENT/TEACHER CONFERENCES What questions should I ask?

The questions you ask during a parent teacher conference can help you express your hopes for your child's success in class and for the teacher.

- What subject does my child seem to like most? Least?
- Is my child trying as hard as he or she can?
- Does my child participate in class discussions and activities?
- What can I do to help my child with subjects he or she finds difficult?
- Is my child in different classes or groups for different subjects? Which ones?
- How well does my child get along with others?
- What can I do at home with my child to reinforce what you are teaching in class?



FEDERAL IMPACT AID SURVEY
