New Pass and ID Program

During the next several months, Naval Support Activity Bethesda (NSAB) Pass and ID Office will be issuing new decals for privately owned vehicles. This is necessary as we transition to a brand new database that will house all vehicle information. All staff on campus will be issued new decals.

Additionally, a newly formatted staff ID Badge will be issued to all personnel who are required to display one on their person except USU and AFRRRI. USU and AFRRRI staff will retain their ID Badges.

Distribution of vehicle decals and Staff ID Badges will take place simultaneously during the same visit. The distribution schedule will be by directorate and command. The schedule of the rollout was sent out in a recent postmaster. August and September's schedule is listed below

What you may receive?

- DoD Decal: If you currently have a DoD Decal on your vehicle you will not be required to receive another. However, you will need to bring the DoD Decal number to the distribution location in order to catalog the number with the Pass & ID office.

- Installation Decal: Those at USU and AFRRRI will be able to maintain a NAVDIST WASH, NNMC, AFRRRI or Uniform Services University Decal. The rest of the campus will be able to maintain a NNMC or NAVDIST WASH decal. You will need to notify the Pass & ID office staff at distribution of this current sticker. If you do not have an installation decal, or have an installation decal from any other facility, you will need to scrape your current decal, bring to the distribution table and receive a new installation decal.

- Expiration Date Decal: If you have a current month & year expiration date for your decal you will be able to keep this on your vehicle. However, you will need to notify the Pass & ID office staff at distribution of this current sticker. If you only have a year sticker, or an expired month & year sticker, you will need to scrape the decal, bring to the distribution table and receive a new installation decal.

All new DoD vehicle decals, and parking assignment stickers must be in place and will be strictly enforced as of 1 January 2011. In the coming weeks the parking policy will be sent for distribution that will outline the enforcement practices that will be in place.

Renovation of New Entry Points at the five entrances will begin soon...

Renovation of new Entry Points at the five entrances to the Campus (North Wood Road Gate, South Wood Road Gate, University Road Gate, Gunnel Road Gate, and Grier Road Gate) will commence soon.

They will provide more secure installation ingress and egress consistent with Anti Terrorism Force Protection guidelines. Furthermore, these renovations will improve traffic flow inbound and outbound of the base as well as

provide dedicated bicycle lanes where possible and improved conditions for pedestrians.

The design build contract for North Wood Road Gate and South Wood Road Gate was awarded to Clark Balfour Beatty Joint Venture in the Spring of 2010. Anticipated start of construction for North Wood Road Gate will be on, or about, about September 2010 and will run up to April of 2011. South Wood Road Gate will begin on, or

about, April of 2011 and will run up to August of 2011.

The award for the University Road Gate was to Whiting Turner Construction in July of 2010 with construction to begin in 2011.

Gunnel Road Gate and Grier Road Gate contracts will be awarded at a future date in 2011.

Parking News



- A 1200 space multi-use parking garage is under construction on the former location of K lot and R lot. Construction fencing has gone up and site work has commenced. These lots are no longer available for staff parking. Construction will complete in August 2011.
- A temporary parking lot with 145 spaces has been created near the fitness

center on Taylor Road.

- Carpool parking decals can be obtained at the distribution of parking stickers at the Pass & ID office or outside of the cafeteria at USU for USU and AFRRRI personnel. Available carpool parking is in the America Garage on the second deck and in the USU garage on the lower level.
- When exiting the base from Palmer Road South head-

ing toward South Gate please be aware of a new traffic pattern. There is now only one lane exiting to accommodate the future Emergency Room entrance.

- Construction continues on campus. Stay tuned to future newsletter editions, postmasters and town halls related to lot closures and roadway disturbances.
