

Navy conducts Security exercise Aug. 11-13

PEARL HARBOR, HAWAII – The Navy will conduct a Security field training exercise at Naval Station Pearl Harbor Aug. 11-13 to evaluate the interoperability of ashore and afloat security forces. During the drills, Navy vessels will respond to simulated incidents involving the firing of blank ammunition rounds, which could be heard in the vicinity of Pearl Harbor. The drills will not affect operations and visitors at the nearby Arizona Memorial, Battleship Missouri Memorial, USS Bowfin Submarine Museum, and Pacific Aviation Museum.

On Aug. 13, enhanced security measures will be in place, and drivers may experience 10-15 minute delays to normal base traffic at Nimitz, Makalapa, Halawa and Porter gates at Pearl Harbor and the surrounding roads. No other impacts to the community are expected. The Navy appreciates the public's patience during the exercise.
