

Navy Region Hawaii sets Hurricane Condition 4

PEARL HARBOR, HAWAII – Commander, Navy Region Hawaii has set Hurricane Condition 4 for Navy commands on Oahu and Kauai.

This is the time to review and restock your Disaster Kit.

Your Disaster Kit should include these basics: water, food, first aid supplies, clothing and bedding, tools and emergency supplies and any special requirements such as medications, special items for infants, elderly or disabled family members and remember to pack important family documents in a waterproof container. Don't forget an extra set of car keys, cash, a credit card or traveler's checks.

These basic requirements should be stored in a sturdy, easy to carry container such as a backpack, duffle bag, or covered trash container.

Be sure and have a three-day supply of water and food that will not spoil. At this time, you should assemble your Disaster Kit and the supplies that you will need if you must evacuate your home for a shelter or safe haven.

Safe Haven (Navy shelters) registration sites will be activated if and when Hurricane Condition 2 is announced. Safe Haven registration sites include the following locations: The Navy Exchange at Pearl Harbor, Building 600 at Naval Magazine Pearl Harbor at West Loch, on board the Naval Computer Telecommunications Area Master Station Pacific in Building 5 and the Pacific Missile Range's Building 384.

Navy families and personnel are highly encouraged to stay tuned to local television and radio stations for the latest advisories. And a complete list of essential supplies can be viewed on the Navy Region Hawaii Web site at www.hawaii.navy.mil (personnel support/emergency preparedness).
