AT Level I Training Requirements

Revised 13 May 2004

Advances awareness, need to maintain vigilance for possible terrorist actions and employ AT tactics, alertness and application of personal protection measures.

- **As soon as practical (preferably at INDOC)**
 - All military, DoD and contractor employees (specified in contract)
 - All local nationals hired by DoD
- **Prior to travel**
 - Family members over 14 yrs old accompanying sponsor PCS overseas
 - Younger at the discretion of the DoD Sponsor
 - Commander should encourage training prior to any OCONUS travel
- **Annually**
 - All OCONUS based DoD personnel
 - All CONUS based DoD personnel eligible for OCONUS deployment
 - All CONUS based DoD personnel when Threat level is moderate or >
 - All active uniformed CONUS based personnel

AOR Specific Brief Requirements

Revised 13 May 2004

Includes detailed, focused information on potential terrorist threats to aid in the development of AT Planning.

- **As soon as practical**
 - All service members, DoD personnel and contract employees
- **Prior to travel**
 - Losing CINC ensures personnel receive gaining CINC requirements
 - Transiting units must be provided similar information
 - Transiting units will receive detailed threat info/transiting routes/site info
 - Update within three months of travel
- **Upon arrival**
 - All DoD personnel must be provided access to AOR specific information on AT protection

1. FORCE PROTECTION CONDITION (FPCON). Source: USPACOM
