Not only is Security the largest department in CFAS, it has perhaps the largest responsibility. Security is charged with the protection of life and property, and with enforcing laws and regulations to preserve good order and discipline.

Their area of responsibility encompasses far more than the average person might realize. The most obvious areas patrolled by Security are the many facilities that make up Main Base, including the piers that act as homeport for Expeditionary Strike Group 7, Dragon Vale housing and Hario Village housing.

If those patrols were the only responsibilities Security had, theirs would still be a tough job but there is more. They exercise their authority to protect life and valuable assets of the United States in five other major facilities.

The services Security provides on land enable the fleet to operate at an incredibly high tempo, as well as enabling service members and their families to feel safe when they sleep at night.

The waterfront is another area where Security's presence is invaluable. They patrol over 1,500 acres protecting ship facilities from waterborne threats.
