1. Purpose. To promulgate procedures for issuance of an Allied  
Forces Italy (AFI) Driver License to eligible personnel in the  
Naples Community.

2. Cancellation. NAVSUPPACT NAPLES INSTRUCTION 11240.29C.

3. Applicability. This instruction applies to all U.S.  
Department of Defense military and civilian personnel (to  
include members assigned to Joint Forces Command) and their  
dependents assigned to the Naples Community and desiring the  
issuance of an AFI Driver License (enclosure 1) or U.S. Forces  
in Italy Motor Vehicle Operators License (enclosure 2) from the  
Central Motor Vehicle Registration Office (CMVRO).

4. Authority. Per reference (a), the Commanding Officer, U.S.  
Naval Support Activity (NAVSUPPACT), Naples, Italy is ultimately  
responsible for establishing policy on the issuance of motor  
vehicle operator permits and controlling licensing procedures

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for all U.S. personnel assigned to the territory south of a line drawn east-west through Grosseto, including the Islands of Sardinia and Sicily. The Commanding Officer has further delegated AFI Driver License and program management authority to the Commanding Officer, U.S. Naval Air Station Sigonella for all personnel assigned to the Island of Sicily.

5. Background

a. Reference (a) provides that no one will drive an AFI-plated vehicle who is not entitled to do so and who is not in possession of an AFI Driver License or U.S. Forces in Italy Motor Vehicle Operators License, or a valid Operator's License accompanied by an official translation certified by the sponsor's command, attesting to the sponsor's status and the driver's authorization to use the sponsor's vehicle.

b. U.S. Department of Defense military and civilian personnel and their dependents are granted the privilege of operating a privately owned vehicle (POV) while stationed in Italy, if they comply with the conditions set forth by the U.S. and Italian Governments, as administered by NAVSUPPACT Naples, and as set forth in reference (a).

c. Per reference (b), U.S. authorities are authorized to issue an AFI Drivers License or U.S. Forces in Italy Motor Vehicle Operators License to U.S. Department of Defense military and civilian personnel and their dependents only after ascertaining the driving capability and knowledge of the Italian traffic rules.

6. Eligibility. In order for an individual to be issued an AFI Driver License, U.S. Forces in Italy Motor Vehicle Operators License, or an official translation for NATO personnel, the applicant must satisfy all of the following eligibility criteria:

a. Be at least eighteen years of age at the time of application.

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b. Possess one of the following:

(1) A valid driver's license from one of the fifty states or U.S. territories.

(2) A valid driver's license from another country.

(3) A valid International Driver's License.

c. Attend Local Driver Safety Indoctrination Training.

(1) Because of the many differences in traffic laws and customs between the U.S. and Italy, a formalized Local Driver Safety Indoctrination Training has been developed. Attendance at the indoctrination training is required to ensure drivers are aware of local driving conditions. Per reference (d), all Department of the Navy (DON) personnel (military and civilian) assigned to the Naples community (including Joint Forces Command) must attend the local traffic safety course.

(2) CMVRO will not issue an AFI Driver License or U.S. Forces in Italy Motor Vehicle Operators License to DON personnel prior to attending this local orientation training. The training will be conducted by NSA Safety Office personnel as part of the Fleet and Family Support Center's (FFSC) Area Orientation.

d. Successfully pass the Italian Road Sign Test.

(1) An Italian Road Sign study guide is issued by FFSC personnel on the first day of the Area Orientation Program. All U.S. personnel must pass an Italian Road Sign test prior to the issuance of an AFI Driver License. The test will consist of forty-eight multiple-choice questions; forty-six of forty-eight questions must be answered correctly to receive a passing grade. Individuals who fail the test three times will be scheduled for remedial driver training and re-tested at a later date.

e. Members with a valid USAREUR U.S. Forces Certificate of License (AE Form 190-1F) will not need to take the Italian Road

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Sign Test but are required to attend the local Driver Safety Orientation Course prior to issuance of the AFI Driver License.

f. Italian Nationals who are also dependants of AFI eligible military or civilian members must obtain a valid Italian License within one year of residency. The valid Italian License is required in conjunction with the AFI Driver License or U.S. Forces in Italy Motor Vehicle Operators License to operated an AFI registered vehicle.

g. The Translation of Motor Vehicle Operators License (enclosure 3) issued by Joint Forces Command is only used for NATO personnel and their dependants. All U.S. Department of Defense personnel (military and civilian) assigned to the Naples community will be issued an AFI Driver License or U.S. Forces in Italy Motor Vehicle Operators License.

7. Expiration Date of AFI Driver License. The expiration date on the AFI Driver License or U.S. Forces in Italy Motor Vehicle Operators License will be as follows:

a. For U.S. military, DOD civilian and their dependents:

(1) Five years when accompanied by a valid United States DOD/Uniformed Services Identification and Privilege Card.

b. For DOD contractors and their dependants:

(1) The AFI Driver License or U.S. Forces in Italy Motor Vehicle Operators License will expire on the date of expiration of member's Letter of Logistical Support.

c. For dependents who are also Italian Nationals:

(1) Without Valid Italian Driver License: One year from date of arrival.

(2) With Valid Italian Driver License: Expiration date of Italian Driver License or 30 days after the sponsor's PRD/DEROS, whichever is earlier.

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d. Regardless of the expiration date annotated on the license, all AFI Driver Licenses or U.S. Forces in Italy Motor Vehicle Operators Licenses expire when AFI privileges are no longer authorized due to retirement, separation, or loss of logistic support privileges.

e. All U.S. personnel should strive to maintain a valid stateside license for use while TAD/TDY or "On Leave" in the United States. See Enclosure (4) for states/territories which allows for automatic renewal of state side licenses for active duty members out of state.

f. Some CONUS police departments and car rental companies may not acknowledge the AFI Driver License as a valid license. CMVRO will issue a letter indicating the AFI Driver License is considered a valid license under Article IV of the NATO Status of Forces Agreement if required. Please check with your local Department of Motor Vehicle (DMV) and Rental Car Company prior to requesting this letter.

#### 8. Temporary Licenses

a. Personnel in a TAD/TDY status. Personnel in a TAD/TDY status for less than 60 days may receive an AFI Driver License or U.S. Forces in Italy Motor Vehicle Operators License without the required local orientation training and testing but must comply with the requirements of subparagraphs 6a and b above. They must attach one of the licenses identified in subparagraph 6b and a copy of their TAD/TDY orders to the AFI Driver License Application (Enclosure 5). The license will be issued for the duration of the TAD period, not to exceed 60 days. TAD/TDY personnel will be issued a copy of the road signs study guide and will be held accountable for its contents and for complying with all Italian traffic laws.

#### b. Other Cases

(1) Members who arrive with an expired stateside licenses.

(a) A 60-day temporary AFI Driver License or U.S.

Forces in Italy Motor Vehicle Operators License may be issued if the member arrives in the Naples community with an expired stateside license, upon verification that the individual submitted a proper renewal request to his/her licensing authority prior to expiration. Exceptions to this policy will be granted on a case-by-case basis due to extenuating circumstances. Submittal of a license renewal is the individual's responsibility. The Motor Vehicle Registration Office can provide assistance with information concerning addresses and telephone numbers of licensing authorities found in the American Automobile Association Digest of Motor Laws, or similar publication.

(b) Cases will undoubtedly arise where personnel have made "good-faith" attempts to obtain an updated license from their licensing authorities and have failed to receive them. In these cases, after the applicant has met the requirements of paragraphs 6a, c, and d, and presented some firm proof of correspondence with the licensing authority, an extension not to exceed the tour length or period of employment of the sponsor, may be granted. In the absence of proof of correspondence, a written statement by the applicant attesting to his/her attempts may be submitted with the application. Applications submitted under this subparagraph will be considered on a case-by-case basis.

(2) Sixty-day temporary licenses shall not be issued for any purpose other than lost, stolen, or expired stateside licenses. Temporary licenses will not be granted if the individual's driving privileges have been revoked or suspended by the Commanding Officer, or other competent authority (e.g. DMV issuing activity).

#### 9. Motorcycles and Mopeds

a. Operation. In order to operate a motorcycle (50cc and above), moped, low speed vehicle or any other motorized bicycle (49cc and below), personnel must meet requirements set in subparagraphs 6a, b, c, and d of this instruction, and must qualify within one of the following categories:

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(1) Stateside Motorcycle Endorsement Category

(a) Possess a valid stateside driver's license with a "motorcycle endorsement;" and

(b) Be registered (with an official letter provided by the NSA Naples Traffic Safety Office) as having successfully completed the Motorcycle Safety Foundation Approved Motorcycle Safety Course administered by NAVSUPPACT Naples, or have in his/her possession records indicating that a Motorcycle Safety Foundation Course was completed within the past two years.

(c) Be retested and complete two off-base rides with a qualified NSA Naples Mentor.

(2) No Stateside Motorcycle Endorsement Category

(a) Possess a valid driver's license from a state and successfully completed the Motorcycle Safety Foundation Approved Motorcycle Safety Course administered by NAVSUPPACT Naples.

(b) Attend required classroom safety training (10 hrs).

b. Motorcycle Registration Restrictions. An individual who qualifies for category 9(a)(2) above, may be allowed to complete a "Limited Registration" of their motorcycle without having completed the Motorcycle Safety Foundation Course. However, the individual must have an official letter stating that they are registered for said course. Failure to attend the scheduled Motorcycle Safety Foundation Course will result in the suspension of Tax Free Gas Coupon Privileges until the course is completed.

c. Motorcycle Validation Process. The U.S. Forces in Italy Motor Vehicle Operators License will be stamped with "validated for two-wheeled motor vehicle operation" upon satisfaction of the requirements identified in this instruction. AFI Driver

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Licenses will be reissued and updated with class A driver's endorsement (front of license item #9).

d. DOD personnel (military or civilian) and their dependants must be 18 years of age to operate a motorcycle, moped (49cc and below), low speed vehicle (designed for street use) or any other motorized bicycle.

10. Temporary Suspension. Suspensions and revocations of AFI Driver License, U.S. Forces in Italy Motor Vehicle Operators Licenses or Translation of Motor Vehicle Operators Licenses are regulated by reference (c).

11. Implied Consent Provision. Persons who have an AFI Driver License or who operate a POV are understood to have given their consent to chemical tests for alcohol or other drugs on their breath or in their blood or urine if lawfully stopped, apprehended, or cited for any offense allegedly committed while driving or otherwise in physical control of a motor vehicle. Licensees who refuse to submit to testing administered by U.S. Forces or Italian civil authorities will have their AFI Driver License privileges revoked.

12. Lost or Stolen Licenses. In the event an AFI Driver License or U.S. Forces in Italy Motor Vehicle Operators License is lost or stolen, the individual must report to the local Security office to make a voluntary statement about the circumstance surrounding the loss. Proof of this voluntary statement must be presented to the CMVRO so they can make a duplicate copy.

13. Travel to Other European Countries. Some countries in the European Union will not acknowledge the AFI Driver License when accompanied with a valid U.S. DOD/Uniformed Services Identification and Privilege Card, and require individuals to have an International Driver's License in their possession. For the most up-to-date information see Appendix D of AE Pamphlet 190-34 at <http://rmv.hqusareur.army.mil/drivrman/ss190-34.htm>. Applications for an International License can be obtained at CMVRO or on-line via the internet. You should be aware that

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International Driver's Licenses are not valid in the issuing country.

14. International Certificate of Insurance. An International Certificate of Insurance (green card) is required in most European countries, and may be obtained from your insurance company. The international certificate of insurance must be valid for the entire time outside of Italy, and should be displayed in the windshield of your vehicle.

15. Responsibility. The Director, Central Motor Vehicle Registration Office (CMVRO) is responsible for the overall coordination of the issuing of the U.S. Forces in Italy Motor Vehicle Operators License or AFI Driver License.

16. Unusual Cases. Specific cases not addressed by this instruction will be forwarded to the Director, CMVRO for resolution.
