BHC Kingsville: Season Flu Vaccines available beginning 01Nov2009.


BHC Fort Worth: Seasonal Flu for Active duty and Reservist Only.

Texas Statewide Hot Line for Flu Advice

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Texans can now dial 2-1-1 to receive medical guidance about flu symptoms and/or H1N1. Medical professionals are available to provide information about managing flu symptoms and advice on when to seek medical care from your PCM or Emergency Room. Callers are instructed to choose a language and then press “6” for flu information and guidance. Services are available 24 hours a day - 7 days a week.

If you require **After Hours Care**, such as for a sore throat, cough or rising temperature, and you are enrolled in TRICARE Prime, the Medical Officer of the Day must be contacted at (361)961-6000 to obtain authorization for care.

The NHCCC Flu Hot Line will provide the most up to date seasonal flu/H1N1 clinic information and is available 24/7.

Patients can choose “0” to schedule an appointment or to speak to a triage nurse during normal hours.

Tricare Prime Enrolled Patients requiring After Hours Care must call (361)961-6000 to obtain authorization for care.

Naval Health Clinic Corpus Christi is monitoring concerns about H1N1 flu and seasonal flu closely. To protect yourself and others from this and seasonal flu and H1N1, CDC recommends everyone “Take 3” actions to fight the flu.

Prime bene to Non-Network provider <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Requires a referral ▪ With a referral—bene may be assessed a copay for the office visit (unless ADSM/ADFM) ▪ Without a referral—pays POS 	Prime bene to Non-Network provider <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Does NOT require a referral if visit solely related to H1N1 vaccination ▪ No co-pay assessed if visit solely related to H1N1 vaccination (or if bene is ADSM or ADFM)

After Hours Access To Care

If you require after hours medical care—such as for a sore throat, cough or rising temperature, and you are enrolled in TRICARE Prime, you must contact the Medical Officer of the Day to obtain instruction and/or authorization for care. Please contact the clinic you are enrolled to as listed below.
