1. Per references (a) and (b), an external audit for NAVSUPPACT Naples, Environmental Management System (EMS) Program was conducted on 3 to 7 May 2010 by Commander, Navy Installations Command (CNIC), Navy Facilities Engineering Command Atlantic (NAVFAC Atlantic) and Navy Facilities Europe, Africa, Southwest Asia (NAVFAC EURAFSWA). No major non-conformances were documented during the audit. Four minor non-conformances were identified during the audit and as required by reference (b), corrective actions addressing each non-conformance have been documented and approved by the audit team.

2. In accordance with references (a) and (b), NAVSUPPACT Naples, has fully implemented an EMS that conforms to ISO 14001:2004.
