ACT Exam Test Dates:

16 Nov, 18 Jan, 21 Mar,
16 May, 18 Jul, 15 Aug, 19 Sep

SAT Exam Test Dates:

19 Oct, 21 Dec, 15 Feb,
18 Apr, 20 June*

*Note: 20 June will be the last exam date offered this FY. The next SAT after June will be in October!

GED Exams, for non-high school graduates, are offered by appointment only. Call us.

Requirements:

- 1) Register in advance!
- 2) Show time NLT 0710, to complete sign-in/registration process.
- 3) ACT/SAT testing begins PROMPTLY at 0730.
- 4) Sorry, late arrivals are not admitted.
- 5) Results take 6-8 weeks.
- 6) Bring your own calculator for ACT/SAT. It must meet certain testing specifications.
- 7) NO CELL PHONES ALLOWED
- 8) Bring your military ID and one other picture ID.

Sorry, only Active Duty members are eligible to sit for the exams listed above, per DANTES.

Register in advance. Tests are held only on Tuesdays!

CLEP (College Level Examination Program): These are course challenge exams offered at the lower level (Freshman/Sophomore level). Check with your college for a listing of which CLEP's are acceptable for your degree program as well as what they require as a passing score. Policy varies from school to school.

DSST (DANTES Subject Standardized Tests): These are also course challenge exams at both the lower and upper level. Again, check with your school as to which exams are acceptable towards your degree requirements.

***Note:** For Active Duty, test fees for each CLEP/DSST exam is paid by DANTES, when taking an exam for the first time. Repeat exams are not funded.

Excelsior College Exams: These are course challenge exams too. Check with your college for their acceptance policy.
