Subj: 2012 OBSERVANCE OF FEDERAL HOLIDAYS

Ref: (a) 5 U.S.C. 6103  
(b) NASSIGINST 1050.1K

1. Purpose. To promulgate dates, which will be observed as federal holidays for the year 2012.
2. Scope. This notice is applicable to all U.S. Navy personnel and may be adopted by tenant commands onboard NASSIG.
3. Holidays. Per reference (a), the following holidays will be observed in 2012:

1 January	New Year's Day	30 December-2 January
16 January	Martin Luther King, Jr. Birthday	13-16 January
20 February	Washington's Birthday	17-20 February
28 May	Memorial Day	25-28 May
4 July	Independence Day	4 July
3 September	Labor Day	31 August-3 September
8 October	Columbus Day	5-8 October
11 November	Veteran's Day	9-12 November
22 November	Thanksgiving Day	22-25 November
25 December	Christmas Day	22-25 December

4. Responsibility

a. Department Heads are charged with knowing their Sailors' plans for the holiday period. Statistics show that holiday periods can be dangerous due to complacency and accidental injuries. All personnel shall utilize Operational Risk Management in their decision making process.

b. Department Heads shall ensure all operational commitments are met during the Special Liberty periods.

c. Liberal leave is authorized for U.S. civilian employees.

d. Per reference (b), approved Special Request chits are required for all personnel traveling off the island of Sicily throughout the European Union. Approved Leave Request chits are required for all personnel traveling outside of the European Union.
