

## REGISTRATION INFORMATION

[Frequently Asked Questions](#) about school registration

Students registering for public school must attend the school zoned for their residence. Parents should register at that school and present the following information:

- Proof of child's date of birth
- Proof of residency
- SSN
- Withdrawal or transfer

If enrolling in Maryland for the first time, parents will also need to present the following health immunization record and documentation of physical exam.

### Pre-K

The pre-kindergarten program was developed in 1979 by the Maryland State Department of Education to meet the needs of low income students who may not have the necessary readiness skills to be successful in school. Students are selected for pre-kindergarten based on the criteria and guidelines set by the Maryland State Department of Education and the public schools system. **Children must be four years old by September 1, 2011 to be considered for the prekindergarten program and meet prioritized criteria.**

### Kindergarten

To enroll in Kindergarten, children must be the 5 years old by Sept. 1 of the current school year.
